	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them		
	access to the area.

	gas towards the demonstrators preventing them from reaching to the confiscated		
	lands and detained 4 international activists.		
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction stopped due to Jewish holiday.		

### At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. **ALL** DISTRICTS On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards north Gaza and Rafah from military ships. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad **NORTHERN** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **GAZA** Attacks: On 28.04.2012, Israeli forces fired from its military ships against Palestinian fishermen boats near Beit Lahia town. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the (i) Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, (ii) the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attacks: On 28.04.2012, Israeli military positioned at the green line fired towards Palestinian agricultural lands in Al Karara village in Khan Younis. Khan Younis **Detention:** At 28.04.2012, Israeli forces detained 2 people while crossing into the borders with Israel. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (i) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is opened (ii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iii) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed (iv) **RAFAH** Attacks: (i) On 28.04.2012 in the morning, Israeli military war ships fired towards Palestinian fishermen boats near Rafah Shore. (ii) On 28.04.2012 in the evening, Israeli military war ships fired towards Palestinian
