<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Duqu village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:25, Israeli forces raided a Bedouin community located in Wadi Abu Al-Nuwar area in east Al-Eizariya and served 43 families military orders to abandon the area within 1 month in order to forcibly remove them to Abu Dis. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqu village, clashed with several residents, detained a residents then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces detained the child Maher Sarhan (15 years old) after assaulting him in Silwan neighbourhood. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Al-Za’tari and Ahmad Al-Za’tari in Wadi Al-Jouz neighbourhood. (iii) Israeli forces detained Nour Rayan in Beit Duqu village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Suwana neighbourhoods fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah Bridge. • Raid: At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Ni’lin and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Issam Khawajah in Ni’lin. • Attack: On the evening of April 28th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several International peace activists as they were rebuilding a home which was demolished by Israeli forces as mentioned in the previous report.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Dan village until 11:45. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabada until 14:50. (ii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 02:25. • Attack: At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Barta’a checkpoint opened fire as they conducted Military exercises in the area. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamalah checkpoint detained Mohammad Qubaha (A resident of Turah village). (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at a Military checkpoint detained Mohammad Jalhoum (A Taxi Driver) {a resident of Jenin} as he was returning from Jericho. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Magolia” settlement junction near Bardalah village. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Bardalah village then stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Far’ah camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Anas Abbas in Al-Far’a camp.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Allar until 12:30. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Sayda village then stormed an Aluminium factory and a merchant shop. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Allar, stormed a home, temporarily detained Mujahid Shadid as they stormed a merchant shop and released him after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 11:30. • Attack: At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghashouri” Factories in West

	<p>Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents protesting against the factories and construction of the Wall and as a result injured Jihad Hamad leaving him hospitalised with contusions.</p>
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Nablus and Iraq Burin village until 16:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Aqraba village. (iii) At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Osirin village until 16:10. (iv) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Qabalan. (v) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Beita. (vi) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balata camp, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 04:45.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned near "Ariel" settlement

<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-New'meh village located at the north entrance of Jericho, temporarily detained Baha' Jum'a (A National Security Force officer) then released him at 17:40. • Raid: At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Jericho, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 01:40. • Home Demolition: At 06:45 on April 26th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Jiftlik village and demolished four barracks owned by Fathi Tariq, Mohammad Du'ies, Mahmoud Da'ies and Yacoub Da'ies for allegedly being built without a licence.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on April 29th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Aza camp in Bethlehem, stormed a home and detained a resident.

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp until 20:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and detained a resident. (ii) At 11:45 and again at 01:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home detained a resident then withdrew at 05:05. (iii) At dawn on April 29th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes, and detained nine residents including two children. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned along road (60) near Beit Ummar detained Nasser Ayash (A resident of Beit Ummar). (ii) Israeli forces detained Jihad Masalmeh in Beit Awwa. (iii) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Al-Junaidi in Hebron. (iv) Israeli forces detained nine residents: Muhanad Arrar (16 years old), Nassim Abu Mariya (17 years old), Yusef Awwad, Nour Awad, Ayham Sabarneh, Hassan Khalil, Maen Abu Ayash, Yaha Za’aqiq and Mahdi Khamis in Beit Ummar. • <u>Attack:</u> On April 28th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Abu Rish checkpoint located near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:05, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child Shihadeh Al-Amour (5 years old) along road (60) in east Yatta and as a result, left him hospitalized.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and Central Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Khan Yunis.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of April 28th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores of Al-Sudaniya located in west Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents on agricultural land near Al-Shiuhada cemetery located in east Jabaliya.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 09:15, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Deir Al-Balah.
<p>KHAN YUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 20:15, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores of Khan Yunis.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
