<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road until 12:50.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.</li> </ul>

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NABLUS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 23:25, Israeli forces increased their restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:45.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furik junction until 01:20.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction, impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged shooting towards a settler vehicle and then resumed the free flow of traffic at 23:45.</li> <li>(iii) At 04:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Bithan and Al-Nassriya village junctions until 04:55.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided the valley of Salem village until 11:50.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajjan until 24:00.</li> <li>(iii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Odala village, fired flash and stun grenades as they searched a home then withdrew at 02:30.</li> <li>(iv) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew 04:30.</li> <li>(v) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Ghassan Hiroun in Nablus.</li> </ul>

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Tartous village.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:20 and again at 03:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Farsh Al-Hawa area located in north Hebron.</li> <li>(iii) At 00:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Tabaqa village junction.</li> <li>(iv) At 00:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron.</li> <li>(v) At 02:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ithna junction.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> On the morning of July 31<sup>st</sup> 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village, clashed with residents as they stormed a home and detained a resident.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Ras in Al-Tabaqa village.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and teargas grenades towards residents gathered at the funeral for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocation from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Settler Violence:</b> At 11:10, Israeli settlers raided Imneizil village in Yatta and assaulted Mohammad Sabaha leaving him hospitalised with contusions.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.</li> </ul>

The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00.</li> <li>• On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Central Gaza and Khan Yunis.</li> <li>• Israeli naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of North Gaza.</li> </ul>
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Point:</b> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on August 1<sup>st</sup> 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Beit Hanoun.</li> <li>(ii) On the morning of August 1<sup>st</sup> 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Beit Lahiya</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
