JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 24th 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound except for Women over the age of 55, Permit holders and men ages 50. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) On the evening of July 24th 2015, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Iksa checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Za’im village road until 19:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces detained Wissam Sadr (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem) after assaulting him. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Daoud (A resident of Beit Duqqu village). (iii) On the evening of July 31st 2015, Israeli forces detained Omar Zidani in Ain Al-Louza area in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Magharba and Hata gates (The main gate entrances leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the North entrance of Al-Isawiya village fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University located in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan and Wadi Al-Juz

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet El" settlement which leads to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 14:50. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Eiyoun Al-Haramiya located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Jerier village until 15:00. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, detained a resident then withdrew at 20:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hassan Hamayel in Kafr Malik village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hassan Abdel-Qadder Hussein. (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired live ammunition; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a child after a bullet struck him to his chest. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed the child Layth Al-Khaldi (16 years old) {A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp} after he was struck by a bullet to his chest. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:45, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 14:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result, several

	others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Al-Far’a and Al-Bithan, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Ali Suhayeb (A resident of Al-Far’a camp) then withdrew at 12:25.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 11:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:25.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village until 09:30. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Raid: At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with several residents and occupied a home owned by Bahjat Salim and converted it into a Military Post then withdrew at 23:50. • Demonstration: At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration who fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach their demonstration site and left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned in the area located in east Beit Furik and at the entrance of Beit Furik fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Anas Fadil (A resident of Askar Camp in Nablus) and also injured Omar Shihadeh (A resident of Beit Furik) after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Deir Al-Hatab and Azmout village junctions and closed the bypass road then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. (ii) On the evening of July 31st 2015, a group of Israeli settlers from “Yitsahar” settlement set fire to a plot of land in Jabal Suliman area located near Assira Al-Qibliya and Orif villages. (iii) At 01:45, a group of Israeli settlers attempted stormed a home located along the outskirts of Duma village but were prevented by local residents.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces closed Za’tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Salfit until 14:00. (ii) At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Harris village until 14:20. (iii) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge until 17:30.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Dura until 20:45. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in an area located in south Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Suhayeb Al-Karaki and Ashour Al-Ajlouni and also left the child Rahaf Abu Zamour suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Halhoul Bridge and Al-Huwar area (located at the north entrance of Halhoul) and at the entrance of Al-Urub, camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Duwar area near the entrance of Sa'ir fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Military broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Gaza and North Gaza and as a result killed a child and injured a resident.
