JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On August 1st 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned near Anata junction fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result set fire to several trees inside the University Campus after a tear gas grenade exploded during which Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the flames. (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu’fat camp and in Al-Sa’aydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenade3s towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira

	Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10 and again at 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 22:20. (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 22:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Turmus’aya. (ii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident and assaulted Sammar Mubarak as she attempted to prevent Israeli forces from detaining her son and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 03:35. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp {during the funeral of Layth Al-Khaldi (16 years old)} fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Ofar” Military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Darwish and Rafid areas in Al-Mughier village, set fire to agricultural land and as a result destroyed 50 Olive trees during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault and as a result injured the child Foad Abu Aliya (17 years old) after he was struck by a tear gas grenade canister to the head and also assaulted 3 residents: Ammar Abu Aliya, Musa Hamdan and Murad Abu Aliya leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area were “Sar Nur” settlement once stood (which was evacuated) until 12:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bardala village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Bardala village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, prevented residents from entering or exiting the area then reopened it at 24:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 17:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum village protesting against the continued closure of the villages east entrance during which Israeli forces fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards protestors and prevented them from reaching the demonstration site and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Salem village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Duma village, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (as they were protesting Israeli settlers violence and the killing of the 18 month old infant by Israeli settlers) and as a result injured Mohammad Bakr Dawabsheh after he was struck by a tear gas grenade canister to the chest. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in the area between Qusra and Jalloud villages, assaulted several farmers on agricultural land during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who attempted to prevent the settler assault and as a result injured 5 residents including a child: Bahjat Hassan (16 years old), Mohammad Hassan, Sa'ed Odeh, Mo'ayad Odeh Naser Mohammad and also Nassar Mohammad was injured after being assaulted by Israeli settlers and left several other suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

	<p>(ii) At 00:55, a group of Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem then withdrew at 02:55.</p> <p>(iii) At 00:55, Israeli settlers stormed Duma village and stoned the home of Wissam Dawabsheh.</p>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Iskaka Village Bridge.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Jericho until 00:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Jericho fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Neje Daniele" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 23:05. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Rakaba area in Al-Khader, clashed with several residents as they stormed Wael Salah's home and assaulted his family. (ii) At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Huasn village then withdrew at 23:30. (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Ayda camp in Bethlehem • Physical Assault: At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement junction assaulted Anas Al-Tubasi (A resident of Al-Rayha village) and left him hospitalised with a severe head injury. • Attack: At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Tarma village junction.
 - (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urob camp, temporarily detained six residents and released them later.
 - (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- **Raid:** At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp, stormed several merchant shops and inspected surveillance camera footage.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 23:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained four residents after storming and searching their home.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained Ayash Awad at the entrance of Beeit Ummar.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Sa'eed Sharif, Mohammad Abu Markhiya, Oday Al-Muhtasib and Ayed Abu Aker in the old city of Hebron.
- **Settler Violence:** At 15:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Halhoul and chopped off the limbs of 20 Olive trees owned by Mohammad Abu Sneineh.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Central Gaza. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launching projectiles towards the Green Line.

(ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents in Bu'ret Abu Samara area located in North West Beit Lahiya. • Detention: At 11:30 on July 28th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Hanun (Erez) crossing detained Ehab Abu Nahel (A resident of Jabaliya).

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Deir Al-Balah and Al-Zuwaydeh (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in south east area of Deir Al-Balah. • Detention: At 08:30, Israeli forces detained two unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel from south east Deir Al-Balah. • Palestinian Attack: At 23:30, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line as alleged by the Israeli Military.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
