(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child: Abdelrahim Jamal Gayth (16 years old) then withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqqu village and summoned two residents to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near the bypass road in Bir Nabalah fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Al-Eisawiya, Al-Tur and Silwan neighbourhoods in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Injury:</u> At 19:00 on August 1st 2014, Sufiyan Ali Sa'adeh was injured during confrontations with Israeli forces in Biddu town as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Taha Al-Khatib in Hizmah village. (ii) At 19:00 on August 1st 2014, Israeli forces detained Malik Aref Amereh during confrontations in Sur Bahar village as mentioned in the previous report. (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abdel-Latif and Jihad Qus in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of July 31st 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .

(ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Turmusaya, Deir Qadis villages and Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a child.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near "Evní Heves" settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near Zeita fired rubber coated steel bullet, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 13:00.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
