JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At dawn on August 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained six residents: Ali Fawaqa, Obayda Ibrahim Amireh, Ahmad Mahmoud Dubish, Samed Abu Senineh, Mazen Al-Halawani and Hussien Al-Qumani in Sur Bahar village. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces prevented several religious students and scholars from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie’ and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni’meh. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, served a demolition, clashed with order to demolish a home owned by Abbas Quran residents then withdrew at 17:20. (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village then stormed and searched several homes. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra’a Al-Sharqiya and detained five children. (iv) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, stormed several homes, detained four residents and summoned Khalil Khaled Al-Nakhlah and his mother to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:55. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained five residents: Nidal Ahmad Abdel-Baqi (14 years old), Mohammad Naffar Shihadeh Hijjaz (14 years old), Najjdat Qaher Zien (15 years old), Abdel-Basset Ahmad Hussien Hijaz (14 years old) and Imad Abdel-Wahab Al-Baqi (13 years old). (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Mahmoud Mohammad Sharaqah, Islam Wadi’ Hassanein, Shadi Mohammad Hassanien and Ahmad Taqfiq Issah in Al-Jalazoun camp. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Al-Nabi Saleh and Deir Qaddis villages fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za’tara village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Ajjah village stormed a chicken farm and a coffee shop then withdrew at 20:00. (iii) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Anza village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Turat village detained two residents: Mahmoud Abdel-Fattah Zied and Suliman Abdel-Fattah Zied and opened fire towards them.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Tubas city, detained a resident, confiscated a vehicle then withdrew at 04:10. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Suliman Samih Sawafta in Tubas city.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evni Heves” settlement. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages until 01:00. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tulkarem and Kafr Al-Labbad village until 24:00. • Raid: At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Zeita, stormed two homes then withdrew at 01:35. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near wall gate (436) located in Quffin fired rubber coated steel bullet, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces positioned near wall gate (104) located in Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullet, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 01:35. • Raid: At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Jayyus and clashed with several residents • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Burin and Madma villages until 09:00. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement junction, temporarily detained and assaulted 3 Security force officers (National Security force and Intelligence officer): Ammar Abdel-Karim Al-Ghani, SalemeH Abdel Karim Al-Ghani and Jari’Shawahneh leaving them hospitalised with contusions • Raids: At 02:40 on August 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Hattab and summoned Tuqay Al-Din Odeh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • Attack: At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqd area located in Beir Furiq fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 02:40. (ii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Bidya and detained three residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Jamil Ibrahim Odeh, Issa Ibrahim Odeh and Salah Assaf Salah in Bidya.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:30 and again at 01:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 02:30. • Attack: At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Jericho rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the

village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 12:00.
- (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem until 14:35.
- (iii) At 18:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 20:30.
- (iv) At 23:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khadr Bridge until 23:30.

• **Raid:**

- (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr and Irtas villages.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Husan village, occupied Yasser Harah's home and converted its rooftop into a military post, imposed a curfew in the east area of the village for alleged stoning of Israeli settler vehicle.
- (iii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur then stormed and searched a home.
- (iv) At 04:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:10.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Mohammad Hammad and Mahmoud Taysir Al-A-Mashiekh.

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces closed the steel gate entrance leading to "Hadgi" settlement in south Hebron. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several homes, and detonated the main entrance of a reception hall then proceeded to storm and search it and summoned Eyad Mohammad Al-Himouni to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning and withdrew at 04:00. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 03:45. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Qasrah area in east in Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Muhyi Salah Musa Idris (11 years old) {Critically injured} and Yusef Abdel-Fattah Salamiya (17 years old). (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thahriya area located in Beit Ummar and near "Kromi Tsur" settlement fired rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp, at Halhul bridge, in Al-Tabaqa area, in Huwar area, in Abu Sneineh neighbourhood located in the old city of Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Ishaq Salim Al-Atrash and detained 3 residents at the entrance of Halhul. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Nidal Samih Karajat, Marwan

GAZA STRIP
