<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents and as a result injured four unidentified residents then withdrew at 23:30. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village then withdrew at 00:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained Mahmoud Abdel-Latif. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood detained the child Farid Jaber (15 years old). • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On August 3rd 2015, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Baba Area in east Al-Eizariya and served military orders for the demolition of 7 residential barracks owned by: Hani Owidat, Ayman Jahalin, Badr Jahalin, Ghassan Jahalin, Yasser Mazar’a, Ali Abu Katifa and Ahmad Tarabin and gave them until August 16th 2015 before implementation. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Hizma village with their vehicle and attempted to abduct the child Qa’qour (15 years old) {A resident

	<p>of Hizma} during which the child's father and several residents were able to prevent the abduction.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet El" settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleeh village until 20:00. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beituniya. (iii) At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ras Kar Kar village junction. • Attack: At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 11:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Ayoun Al-Haramiya area located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus and stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Musa Al-Alameh (A resident of Qabalan in Nablus).
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 20:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:25.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of August 3rd 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Wadi Azzun area in Azzun, set fire to agricultural land and as a result destroyed several Olive trees before Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the fire. (ii) On the evening of August 3rd 2015, an Israeli settler vehicle travelling through Jaljoliya checkpoint near Wall Gate (109) at the east entrance of Qalqiliya ran over Khalaf Masa'id (A resident of Arab Abu Farda village) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30 and again at 02:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in North Huwara. (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Bithan and Al-Nassariya until 22:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On August 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Duma village and detained a resident after storming his home. (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village and detained a resident after storming his home. (iii) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Talfit village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:35. (iv) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq and clashed with several residents. (v) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Nablus and detained a resident after storming his home. (vi) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Subustiya village until 03:50. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Anas Dawabsheh (A resident of Awarta village). (ii) Israeli forces detained Anas Zaydeh in Duma village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Ghazlawi (A resident of Al-Far’a camp in Tubas). (iv) Israeli forces detained Fadil Al-Masri in Nablus. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:00, a group of Israeli settlers attacked a vehicle owned by Murad Raba’ (A resident of Al-Thahriya in Hebron) near Duma village junction and as a result caused the vehicle to over turn.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Iskaka Village Bridge. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Bruqin. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 03:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near Za'tara checkpoint opened fire towards residents for allegedly not stopping at the checkpoint and as a result injured him and then detained him. (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan opened fire towards several residents as they protested the Israeli water authorities' decision to cut off water supplies to the village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned Za'tara checkpoint detained Baha Harizat (A resident of Yatta in Hebron).
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nuwe'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 02:50.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man; a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Neve Daniele" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction located the south entrance of Bethlehem until 15:20.
- (ii) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 22:00.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At dawn on August 3rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Rashaydeh village and summoned Faysal Rashaydeh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 15:05, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a gas station owned by Adnan Hajahja and confiscated surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 15:10.
- (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Nis village until 01:55.
- (iv) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Ayda camp, stormed and searched several homes, detained six residents and summoned 2 children: Ahmad Ja'arat (15 years old) and Abdallah Hammad (16 years old) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:40.
- (v) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwara village summoned Mohammad Al-Dar'I (A National Security Force Officer) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained six residents: Hazim Abu Aker, Sarour Abu Sarour, Muhanad Ja'ra, Ahmad Al-Mashayikh, Samed Hamad and Layth Nasrallah in Ayada camp in Bethlehem.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned near Billal bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at the West entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou' until 21:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained 6 residents and summoned Riyadh Arrar to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The 6 detained in Beit Ummar were: Nour Abu Arar, Hamza Ekhleil, Amer Sabarna, Rami Sabarna, Ibraheem Sabarna Ayesha Awad and Naief Salebi (ii) The detained in Al-Fuwar camp was Suhib Tete. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron assaulted two residents: Abdel-Jawad Ghayth and Abdel Basset Ghayth.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attack: At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land located in east Al-Fukhari village.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
