JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village and stormed a home. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya (Allegedly searching for an alleged assailant who stabbed an Israeli soldier near “Malee Adumin” settlement). (iii) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabalab, stormed and searched several

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie’ and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni’meh. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Sinjil and stormed a home. (iii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Sira village, detained three residents then withdrew at 02:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Akram ALI Alqam, Mohammad Khalid Ahmad Al-Haj and Waleed Riziq Thiyab Kahattab in Beit Sira • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah bridge located at the north entrance of Bir Ziet fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:45, Israeli forces positioned near Buddrus village temporarily detained the child Mohammad Shihadeh (11 years old) for alleged stoning then released him at 12:00.

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabaydeh village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured three residents: Mohammad Hani Abu AL-Rub, Sadam Fawzi Sharqawi and Billal Samir Sharqawi. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:45. (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Malamah village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:10. (iv) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Maythaloun. (v) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Judeideh village, stormed and home and summoned Mohammad Ali Al-Haj to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (vi) At 03:15, Israeli force raided Al-Silah Al-Harhiya and detained a resident. (vii) At 07:00, Israeli forces raided Barta’a Al-Sharqiya, demolished a Baracks owned by Mohammad Ibrahim Qubaha and a vehicle repair shop owned by Raslan Amarat and assaulted Baha Qubbaha (A journalist). • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:45, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Sinan Nayef Hadwan during their raid into Jenin as mentioned in the previous reports. (ii) Israeli forces detained Samer Hassan Jarradat in Al-Silah Al-Harhiya. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at “Movo Dotan” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem temporarily detained Mohammad Abu Arah then released him at 13:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 22:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayassir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of Traffic as well as punctured the tires of several vehicle after placing steel spikes along the road. • <u>Injury:</u> At 04:50 on August 5th 2014, Mohammad Mahmoud Al-Loul was shot in the legs by Israeli forces during their raid into Al-Far’a camp as mentioned in the previous report.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwakiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. (ii) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Kafr Sur village. (iii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Sayda village, stormed a home and summoned Nur Yasser Ajjaj to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<p>of Azzun town.</p> <p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <p>(iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces issued a military order to confiscate a plot of land located between Kafr Thulth and Azzun located near “Malee Shomron” settlement and served notices to the landowners requesting them to issue a dispute regarding the notice. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Assira Al-Shimaliya until 11:30. • <u>Raids:</u> At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Talfit village, stormed the local village council, surveyed surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 11:40. • <u>Detention:</u> At 08:35, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Ihsan Suliman Al-Barghouthi (A National Security Force officer)

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks.

(ii) At 11:20, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nuwe'meh village located in North Jericho until 12:45. • Detention: At 04:05 on August 5th2014, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Mahmoud Tibi during their raid into Aqbat Al-Jabir camp in Jericho as mentioned in the previous report.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. <p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An increase in the number of civilians killed after discovering several bodies beneath the rubble of destroyed homes to 1875 since the Israeli Attack on Gaza • At 08:00 on August 5th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease-fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease-fire for a period of 72 hours (3 days).
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.
