JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikka village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces closed Al-Za’im checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later. (iv) At 21:45, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint which connects Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<p>(iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat and Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in Al-Nabi Samual village detained Suhayeb Mahoud Hussien Samarah (A resident of Biddu). • <u>Injury:</u> On August 6th 2014, Israeli forces injured Yusef Nathmi Salameh (A resident of Hizamah) during confrontations near Hizmah checkpoint. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli Police, Israeli Intelligence officers and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Al-Mahakmah checkpoint near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Deir Ammar and Ras Kar Kar until 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Bir Ziet, searched a building and summoned two residents: Rab'I Raja'I Awad and Rami Awad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Qaddis village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured two residents: Rif'at Othman Jum'a and Bahjat Othman Jum'a then withdrew at 21:25. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Janiya and Ras Kar Kar villages. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On August 6th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Deir Nathim village and uprooted 35 Olive trees owned by Abdel-Nasser Al-Tamimi and 15 Olive trees owned by Munjid Al-Tamimi.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village, clashed with residents as they stormed a home. (ii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, stormed Omar Yaha's home confiscated a computer then withdrew at 05:00

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tubas city, clashed with several residents as they stormed four homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Rawdwan Hamad Masa'id in Tubas city.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village junction in east Anabta, detained a National Security Force Officer then withdrew at 14:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, inspected several water wells then withdrew at 10:00. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Bal'a, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and as a result injured Awad Jamil Saqer Omar (16 years old), detained a resident then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ehab Adnan Atiyeh Shihab (a National Security Force Officer) at Bazariya village junction in east Anabta. (ii) Israeli forces detained Nabil Salah Awad Hamdan in Bal'a.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 14:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, searched a home then withdrew at 08:50. (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with residents as they stormed six homes then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Harris village, stormed two homes, detained two residents then withdrew at 04:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Samer Ayad Ahmad Suf and Farid Ata Suliman in Harris village. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces levelled plots of land south of "Bruqn" settlement for the purpose of settlement expansion.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:10 on August 7th 2014 and again at 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 11:00. (iii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction, temporarily detained Khadr Assi, released him later then withdrew at 10:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 00:40. (ii) At 23:10, Israeli force raided Al-Oja village, temporarily detained three residents (identified): Hamza Jama'at after assaulting them then released them later.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the

village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 12:40.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, served halt to construction orders for 12 homes owned by:Riziq Mahmoud Abu Ghaliyan, Adnan Atiyeh Sbieh, Yusef Abbs Hussien Issa, Hassan Ali Salah, Ahmad Yusef Hussein Issa, Ahmad Zakariya Issa, Na'im Jum'a Ghnayem, Khaled Atwa, Amjad Sa'ed Salah, Khalil Abu Qab', Mohammad Mahmoud Sa'id and Omar Za'rour for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Satih area in Beit Sahur until 21:15.
- (iii)At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village and detained three residents including two children.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained three residents: Muhanad Yosef Hurub (16 years old), Majd Mohammad Manasrah (17 years old) and Nadim Ibrahim Manasrah.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired, rubber coated steel bullets ,stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Wadi' Fayeze Ismail

	<p>Saqr (6 years old).</p> <p>(ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Husan fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p>
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-' Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Duma area in Al-Thahriya until 09:45. (ii) At 09:15 and again at 00:55, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several homes, a mosque and a Center for the disabled and opened fire then withdrew at 03:50. (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Amarah village • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child Rose Talib Jabr (9 years old) in the old city of Hebron leaving her hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli settlers positioned near Beit Anun village junction damaged a vehicle owned by Aziz Al-Froukh.

Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire. • Two residents died from injuries sustained from Israeli assault, which increases the number of civilians killed to 1893 including 432 children, 243 women and 85 residents and the increases in the number of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 9806 including 2979 Children, 1903 Women and 374 Elderly residents. • At 08:00 on August 5th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Killing:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 8th 2014, Mohammad Juma'a Mahmoud Al-Najjar (A resident of Gaza) died of injuries sustained from the Israeli assault on Gaza in a hospital in Jerusalem. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is Partailly open for the entry of humanitarian goods.
