Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jalla, Temporarily detained 2 residents then withdrew at 15:45.
- (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction until 16:10.
- (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar until 03:00.

Settlement Activity:

- (i) On August 5th 2012, Israeli authorities approved the expansion of "Navi Danial" settlement in Al-Khadr by confiscating an additional 400 meters at the settlement entrance and 300 dunumes of civilian land.
- (ii) On August 9th 2012, Israeli settlers opened a park in Wadi Masri area which was under construction since 2000 after they confiscated several plots of civilian land located around a water spring in Irtas village.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

Closure:

- The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling (ii) along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-(v) Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

Flying Checkpoint:

- At 08:30 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint on Tarusa (i) village junction.
- At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Yatta and Al-Samou'. (ii)
- At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction. (iii)
- At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Yunis area. (iv)
- At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron. (v)
- At 00:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awwa. (vi)

Raid:

- (i) At 20:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Samit village.
- (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Khursa village and prevented residents

from entering a mosque to conduct Tarawih prayers.

- (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Dura.
- (iv) At 23:30 and again at 03:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up 2 checkpoints.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces detained Raja Al-Hih and her infant child after storming their home in the old city of Hebron and released them at 24:00.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
