JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Beit Hanina. • <u>Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces detained four residents including three children: Lu'ay Hani Al-Sayad (16 years old), Majdi Al-Hadrah (16 years old), Mohammad Abu Sbieh (16 years old) and Mohammad Jihad Abu Gharbiya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya, fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting the assault on Gaza.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting the assault on Gaza. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:05, Israeli settlers set fire to agricultural land in Mazmuriya area in South Jerusalem and as a result destroyed several Olive trees. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmusaya and detained two residents including a child. (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Awarta, searched a home then withdrew at 05:20. (ii) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of “Ofar” prison/Military Base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near the bypass road in Beituniya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

(iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages until 04:00.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit until 10:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris until 10:20. (iii) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Harris village until 01:50. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 19:05, Israeli Police positioned near "Ariel" settlement assaulted and sprayed pepper spray onto the face of Mohammad Salem Abdel-Fattah Buziya (A resident of Kafil Harris) leaving him hospitalised with contusions and also confiscated his vehicle. • <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces stormed Deir Istiya and occupied Munir Khalil Mansours home and converted it into a military post then clashed with several residents. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Yassuf village, set fire to a vehicle owned by Atallah Yassin Judat and sprayed racist graffiti onto the burnt vehicle.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 09:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Sultan camp in Jericho, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yasser Ibrahim Abu Dahouq in Ein Al-Sultan camp in Jericho. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge, temporarily detained Mohammad Mahmoud Al-Atrash (A National Security Force officer) as he was returning from Jordan then released him later. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge, temporarily detained three Civil Defence officer: Khaled Assad Awinat, Osama Ali Bani Odeh and Mohammad Raja Al-Tibi. As they were travelling for a training course in Jordan and denied, them access to travel.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Abidiya until 11:30. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Harsa area in Beit Sahur until 20:00. (iii)At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village until 20:10. (iv)At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Za'tara and summoned Mohammad Hassan Al-Makhtoub to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to

closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoints:**

- (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahriya.
- (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Baraka area in Yatta.
- (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.

- **Raid:** At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp (for alleged shooting at Israeli forces) and occupied Nash'at Al-Badawi's home, clashed with several residents and detained a National Security Force officer.

- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Mahmoud Ahmad Husniyeh in Al-Urub camp.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident after critically injuring him and injured 13 residents : Ribhi Hadad, Mohammad Ghalib Amr, Ayman Zuhair Bayed, Abdul Rahman Ramadan, Magdi Mazen Qawasmi, Ribhiya Mahmoud Bayed, Mohammad Yaqin Shweiki, Badran Moussa Al-Torah, Ahmed Abu Hussein, Mohamed Tarek Al-Jabari, Abdul Karim Samir al-Dura, Uday Imran Al-Muhtasib, and Islam Tamim Khatib.
- (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Ahmad Abu Hashim (17 years old).

- **Physical Assault:** At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron assaulted Abdel-Jabber Mohammad Al-Haddad and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Since the morning of August 8th 2014, Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah .Tank Artillery fire target several mosques and Beit Hanoun hospital • Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 20 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 12 residents including 3 children, a woman and 3 critically injured patients which increases the number of civilians killed to 1916 and injured 42 residents which increases in the number of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 9875. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 42 projectiles. • At 08:00 on August 5th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease-fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease-fire for a period of 72 hours (3 days).

(ii) At 10:05, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line launched tank artillery shells towards Al-Bidawiya village and injured five residents. • <u>Air Strikes:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards a plot of land in Izbit Abd Raboo area (ii) At 19:30, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards a building in Al-Shiekh Zayed city. (iii) At 22:25, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards Jallal Abu Odehs home in Beit Hanun. (iv) At 01:0, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards Aqashah family home in Jabaliya camp and as a result killed residents and injured 10 others. (v) At 01:15, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards Al-Razina family home in Beit Lahiya and as a result injured five residents. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli airstrikes killed an unidentified residents in Jabaliya • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On August 9th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen launched several projectiles towards the Green Line.
