JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Bab Al-Salasleh gate (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem and raised Israeli flags in a provocative manner. (ii) At 09:50, 3 Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Mikhmas village provoked several residents then withdrew at 12:15. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira

	Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 23:30. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya until 22:45. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, set up a checkpoint at its entrance then withdrew at 05:30. (iii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazr’a Al-Sharkiya and detained a resident. • Killing: At 20:15, Anas Mountasir Taha (A resident of Qutna village) was killed after Israeli forces positioned near wall gate 443 in Kharbatha Al-Misbah village for allegedly stabbing an Israeli settler. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Jad Sa’ied in Al-Mazra’a Al-Sharqiya.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababda, Maythaloun and Sanuir village and clashed with several residents in Al-Zababda. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several residents after storming several homes, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 06:50. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Jihad Arqawi, Ahmad Khader, Yahya Nijim and Awwad Jamal in Jenin. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Demolition: At 10:45, Israeli forces stormed the area near AL-Hamra checkpoint and served military orders to demolish 2 homes owned by Hayel Basharat and Mahmoud Basharat thus giving them 10 days for implementation.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 20:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:40.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Habalah village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Jayyous. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement located in North Huwara until 10:30. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 23:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Nablus as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed Joseph’s Tomb, then clashed with several residents and as a result injured 3 residents and withdrew at 04:05. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Jad’oun” settlement located in east Beit Furik fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area between Assira Al-Qibliya and Madma then set fire to agricultural land during which Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the fire. (ii) At 14:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area between Burin village and “Barja” and “Yitsahar” settlements and set fire to land during which Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the fire. (iii) At 15:10, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Assira Al-Qibliya then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. (iv) At 15:55, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Ainbuis village and set fire to agricultural land during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and Palestinian Civil Defence forces were able to extinguish the fire.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 05:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Ballout, demolished a home and a livestock den owned by Adnan Abdallah for allegedly being built without a licence then withdrew at 06:50.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 02:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) in Al-Oja village. • Detention: At 21:30, Israeli force positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Mahmoud Ja'iedi (A resident of Qalqiliya). • Temporary Detention: At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Jamilah Al-Arjan then released her at 01:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 17:15. (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the North and West entrances of Taqou' and clashed with several residents at the west entrance then withdrew at 20:30.

(ii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Duhisheh camp, clashed with several residents in the camp and summoned Karam Abed Rabbo to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near bypass roads (35) and (60) located in North Hebron. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Yunis area junction located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem) and at the entrance of Sa'ir. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on August 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, stormed several homes, summoned 4 residents including 3 children: Nada Jarradat (14 years old), Alaa Jarradat (14 years old), Abed Al-Lalhilah (14 years old) and Ibrahim Al-Faroukh. (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Khier village located near "Al-Karmil" settlement located in east Yatta and served a military order for the demolition of a water well owned by Ali Dababseh and Mohammed Dabaseh. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Khilat Al-Miya located in east Yatta, served a military order to halt construction on two water well approximately 1700 cm³, which will supply water to Um Safa village for allegedly being built with outa licence. (iv) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Halhoul and summoned Ahmad Jabarar to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:20. (v) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:10. • <u>Detention:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Kafir Itsiyon” settlement detained 3 children: Nada Jaradat (14 years old), Alaa Jaradat (14 years old) and Abed Al-Lalhilah (14 years old) {All residents of Sa’ir}. (ii) Israeli forces detained Waleed Zidat in Bani Na’im. • Temporary Detention: At 09:55, Israeli forces positioned at a flying checkpoint in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained 5 construction workers for the Municipality of Hebron then released them at 10:15.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Khan Yunis.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija’iya (Nahal ‘Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land located in south east Al-Maghazi camp.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 07:40 on August 8th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Khan Yunis. • Detention: At 19:00 on August 8th 2015, Israeli forces detained 3 unidentified residents attempting to climb the border fence from east Khan Yunis city into Israel.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser ‘Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al ‘Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
