- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of “Malee Adumim” settlement until 01:00.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on August 10th 2014, Israeli forces raided Biddu and detained two residents.
 - (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed and searched a home and a women’s hair Salon.
 - (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabalab, stormed and searched several homes, detonated and exploded the main entrance to a building owned by Jihad Al-Nabali then withdrew at 03:00.
- **Attack:** At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, Al-Eizariya, Ras Khamis area, Shu’fat camp and Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained two residents in Shu’fat camp.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Hata area in the old city of Jerusalem detained two residents: Alaa Mohammad Al-Fakhouri and Rami Salah Thiab Al-Fakhouri.
 - (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabbir neighbourhood detained Ahmad Amin Sarour after assaulting him leaving him hospitalised with contusions for allegedly assaulting two Israeli settlers with a steel pipe.
 - (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem detained Mahmoud Al-Tafakji.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Hisham Khadr Hamisan and Ahmad Khalid Al-Shiekh.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained Qusay Omar Abu Khdeir and Taher Abu Khdeir.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:**

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:25, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces stormed Hamza mosque in Beit Safafa village for allegedly sending Humanitarian supplies for residents in Gaza are affected by the Israeli military assault on Gaza. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Turmusaya fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

(iii) Since August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near "Evni Heves" settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Ras village. (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Sur village, opened random fire, installed a checkpoint at the village entrance and prevented residents and vehicles from entering or exiting the village then withdrew at 18:30. (iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusoun, stormed a merchant shop and confiscated surveillance camera footage for the store and Al-Ein (Water Park) then withdrew at 21:30. (iv) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 05:25. (v) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Anabta, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Mohammad Hammad Jara'neh (A resident of Irtah neighbourhood in Tulkarem) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Mustafa Al-Najjar in Anabta. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Far'oun village fired live ammunition towards several children for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:20. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 21:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 22:20. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 00:40. • Raids: At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Qabalan, clashed with its residents as they stormed several home including Zakariya Musa Al-Aqra’(A resident who is wanted by Israeli Authorities) and forced residents out their homes and ordered him to turn himself in to Israeli forces during which Israeli forces opened fire and launched Inertia Bombs towards Kamal Farah Nayef Al-Az’ars home and as a result killed a resident and injured 4 residents including a woman and a child: Kamal Nayef Al-Az’ar, Inshirah Abdel Ra’uf Al-Za’er and the 2 children Nawal Al Aza’r (6 years old) and Yanal (4 years old) and also demolished Muhanad Musa Daoud Al-Aqr’a and demolished 2 storage rooms owned by Jihad Yusef Al-Az’ar and detained an Intelligence officer then withdrew at 08:45. • Killing: Israeli forces killed Zakariya Musa Daoud Al-Aqra. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces detained Jihad Hassan Al-Hindi (A resident of Tel village) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forced detained demolished Muhanad Musa Daoud Al-Aqr’a (An Intelligence officer). • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:40 Israeli forces positioned at a bypass road located near “Alon Muriya” settlement near Salem village, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mahmoud Maher Al-Ajouri (A resident of Askar camp in Nablus). (ii) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned at “Yitsahar” settlement junction opened fire and searched the surrounding area for alleged assailants who hurled a firebomb towards an Israeli Military vehicle. • Settler Violence: At 18:25, a group of Israeli settlers from “Braja” settlement attempted to abduct the child Mahmoud Zuhier Qadies (16 years old) {a resident of Iraq Burin village} as he was herding his sheep near the settlement during which local residents prevented the settler attack.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’
