

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: Israeli troops positioned at checkpoints set up at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem continue to prevent civilians from other districts from entering the city. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and An Nabi Samwil checkpoints and impede civilian access. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the village of 'Anata checkpoint and prevented civilians from entering or exiting the village. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, and in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya. Raid: At 00:30, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of El Bireh and patrolled the area.
JENIN	 Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas leading to the area of the northern Jordan Valley, impeding civilian access. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Raid: At 03:00, the Israeli army, including 30 jeeps, raided the town of 'Arraba and the village of Ar Rama, arrested 9 civilians, and withdrew at 06:00. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 9 civilians in the town of 'Arraba and the village of Ar Rama: Yazan Ali Hardan; Abdul 'Azeez As'ad 'Ardhah; Ala' Nader Izz ad Din; Maher Muhyi Izz ad Din; Abdul Nasser Abu an Nour 'Ardhah; Abdul Ghani Hamad Sabhah;

(vii) Ala' Mufeed Hardan;
(viii) Abdul 'Atheem ash Shibani; and
(ix) Mohammed Nathmat Jum'ah.
 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up on the junction to the settlement of 'Einav along the Tulkarem-Nablus road, preventing civilian vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Flving Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint between the city of Tulkarem and the area of Ash Sha'rawiya, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. At 00:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Far'un and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids/Air Patrol: At 13:55, the Israeli army, supported by helicopters, raided the towns of Bal'a and 'Illar and the village of Al 'Atara and fired sound grenades in the town of Al 'Atara, injuring 2 children and 1 cameraman working for a local TV station. The Israeli army also patrolled the area. At 21:20, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided and patrolled the area of Wadi ash Sha'ir near the town of Bal'a. At 24:00, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem and arrested 1 civilian. Arrests: At 22:00, Israeli troops positioned at Jubara checkpoint halted 1 taxi and arrested Mohammed Sameer an Natour (the taxi driver). The Israeli army arrested Jamal Ibrahim I'lariyyeh in Dahiyat Iktaba. Settler Violence/Physical Assaults: At 08:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Ribhi Jameel Hamad from the village of Ramin near the settlement of 'Einav, after which he was transported to hospital for treatment of injuries sustained. At 14:00, a group of Israeli settlers severely beat 74-year-old Abdul Latif Mas'oud Hamad and 'Aysheh Yaseen Hamad, a 65-year-old female civilian, while they were on their land in the village of Ramin. Both civilians were transported to hospital for treatment of injuries sustained.

 Wall Gates: (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special
Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and search civilians with a metal detector.



	 prevent farmers not holding Jericho IDs from reaching their agricultural land, forcing them to apply for access permits. At various times, the Israeli army also impeded civilian movement into the city of Jericho. Closure of Main Road: At 03:15, the Israeli army closed Road # 90 leading to the area of the northern Jordan Valley, denying civilian access. Checkpoint: At 09:40, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the DCO checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho, and searched civilian vehicles travelling in both directions, impeding civilian access until 10:30. Flying Checkpoint: At 01:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah and searched civilians and vehicles until 03:00.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man, in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers civilians' residence in the village illegal. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala. Raids: At 12:40, an Israeli army patrol raided the village of Dar Salah, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles until 13:20. At 22:20, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided 'Ayda refugee camp, opened fire, fired flares, and searched the vicinity of the cemetery. At 23:45, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. Arrest: At 23:00 on 09 August 2005, the Israeli army arrested Ahmed 'Uweidhah Thawabteh in the area of Jurun al Maniya near the town of Tuqu'.
HEBRON	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh in the H2 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks and barbed wire, denying civilians and vehicles access. The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shallala old and new streets in the H1 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks located 300 meters inside the H1 section. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and as Samoa'. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Yatta and the village of Ar Rihiya and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 08:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.

 (ii) At 13:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, searched a number of houses in the neighbourhood of Nimra, and arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child. Arrests The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the city of Hebron:
(i) Mohammed Akram al Haddad, 15 years old; and (ii) Rami Falah.

GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to humanitarian cases and VIPs only. <u>Palestinian Security Measure</u>: At 17:40, a Palestinian security patrol located and detonated an explosive device north of the town of Beit Lahiya. 		
GAZA	 Closure: (i) Ash Shuhada' – Netzarim Junction remains closed. (ii) Ash Shuhada' Junction - Al Muntar (Karnei) Crossing road is closed. 		
CENTRAL GAZA	Activities not reported.		
KHAN YUNIS	 Closure of Main Roads: Abu Al 'Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) is closed. Western road (Khan Yunis) is closed. Morag road, connecting Khan Yunis' eastern and western roads, is closed. Deir al Balah junction to Abu Holi checkpoint (Kfar Darom road) is closed. Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road is closed. Abu Holi road is open. At 19:30, the Israeli army closed Salah ad Din road between Al Matahin and Abu Holi checkpoints, preventing civilians from crossing in both directions. The Israeli army reopened the road at 06:00. Attacks: At 08:55, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 198 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory. At 11:40, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 11 towards Palestinian territory in An Namsawi neighbourhood in the city of Khan Yunis. At 21:50, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 178 towards Palestinian territory east of the area of Khuza'a. 		

	 Raid: At 12:00, the Israeli army, including 1 tank and 2 bulldozers, raided 100 meters into Palestinian territory near Point 180 on the Green Line east of the area of Khuza'a. Land Levelling: At 09:25, the Israeli army, including 4 bulldozers, levelled land to erect a dirt barricade north of the Kessufim settler bypass road. Settler Violence: At 11:50, a group of Israeli settlers damaged civilian agricultural land west of the settlement of Neve Dekalim opposite West Khan Yunis refugee camp.
RAFAH	 Closure: Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah Crossing is closed to Palestinian civilians under the age of 35. Sufa Crossing is closed. Attack: At 11:50, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 22 towards Palestinian territory in Tall as Sultan neighbourhood in the city of Rafah. Raid/Land Levelling: At 09:30, the Israeli army, including 1 tank and 3 bulldozers, raided 10 meters into Palestinian territory south of Sufa Crossing and levelled land to erect a dirt barricade.

GENERAL

WORK PRMITS	 Gaza Strip: Israeli authorities renewed 720 work permits for workers to enter the Industrial Zones. However, only 404 workers (approximately 56% of those possessing work permits) were allowed access to the Industrial Zones. Israeli authorities renewed 2,017 work permits for workers to cross the Green Line. However, only 164 workers (approximately 8% of those possessing work permits) were allowed access to areas inside the Green Line.
