JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Bir Nabala Bridge. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Malee Adumin” settlement junction located at the east entrance of Al-Eizariya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, detained a resident for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Ikse checkpoint detained Abdallah Al-Shiekh for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier. (ii) Israeli forces detained Basel Nawafa in Abu Dis. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces stormed the Industrial Zone “Aterot” located in North Jerusalem demolished a building consisting of 3 floors 9approxamatly 220 m² owned by Ibrahim Abu Diyab for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 18:40. • Raid: At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya until 14:05.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Jabra and Sanur villages. • Raid: At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Jenin. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Demolition: At 09:30, Israeli forces stormed Khirbeit Hamsa village located in the North Jordan valley demolished 2 residential tents and a live stock den owned by Hayel Basharat and Mahmoud Basharat.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 21:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:10.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints between Jayyuus and Azzun and between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 23:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village, stormed and searched a construction supply store. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Fanduk village and stormed a home. (iii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Jayyuus then stormed and searched a home. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an

	<p>iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq, temporarily detained Izzat Al-Qadder (A National Security Force Officer) then released him at 11:00. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rujieb village until 03:30. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Orif village, stormed and searched a vehicle repair shop then withdrew at 03:30. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balata camp until 04:45. (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Tel village until 02:55. (iv) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Burqa village, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:45. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 11th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained two residents: Mohammad Hanoun and Moath Shihadeh (both residents of Balata camp in Nabus). (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Qadder Salah in Burqa village. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:40, Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Al-Saba’ area located in east Burin village and set fire to agricultural land then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces as Palestinian Civil defence forces extinguished the fire. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli settlers positioned near Huwara checkpoint stoned residents and vehicles passing through the checkpoint then withdrew at 23:00.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: At 19:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:25. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka village bridge.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Harris village, detained a residents after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Wadi' Qulieb in Harris village.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 21:00. (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 23:25. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces positioned along the bypass road in north east Jericho temporarily detained 3 residents (construction workers): Saud Al-Nouri, Osama Arinat and Munir Kashara then released them at 19:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 14:30. (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Za'tara until 19:45.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:30 and again at 01:40, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a plant shop, temporarily detained 3 residents: Basel Al-Amour, Musa Al-Amour and Mahmoud Al-Amour then stormed and searched 4 homes.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urob camp. (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained a resident after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 01:40. (ii) At dawn on August 12th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar until 21:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:15, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Al-Forkh (A resident of Sa'ir) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Nassiem Al-Qawasmi in Hebron. (iii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mu'taz Baher (17 years old), Muhanad Abu Mariya (15 years old) and Bara' Abu Mariya (16 years old) in Beit Ummar. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Nathmi Jarradat then released him after summoning him to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:20, the Israeli Minister of Defence stormed Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron during which Israeli forces closed access to the mosque until 11:45.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Gaza.

<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
