WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on August 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained three residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces detained Wissam Abu Al-Hawa after storming his home in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ahmad Obied, Saher Mustafa and Tarik Darwish in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on property:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces forces the shopkeepers of the old city to close their shops to allow for a demonstration of settlers. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police Officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with earth mounds. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 15:35, Israeli forces closed down Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement located in North Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 17:50. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:50, a group of Israeli settlers stormed a public park in Ain Burin area in Deir Ibzi’ village and chased residents away then withdrew at 16:10.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on August 13th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba junction and detained a resident. (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba’ junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Barta’a Al-Sharqiya village, stormed a gas station owned by Sabri Qubha, confiscated surveillance camera footage then clashed with several residents. (ii) At dawn on August 14th 2015, Israeli forces raided Jenin camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed a vehicle repair shop and confiscated a vehicle owned by Musa Al-Badawi. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hufaytha Jabarin (A resident of Jenin camp) near Arraba junction. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hajja village. (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum. (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Qalqiliya. (iv) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an

	<p>iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 09:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Sarah village junction until 13:00. (ii) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita junction. (iii) At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Tel and Madma villages. • Raid: At 04:35, Israeli forces raided Assira Al-Qibliya village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 05:00. • Detention: At 16:05, Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Shaker Radwan (A resident of Azzun in Qalqiliya), Marwan Huwari (A resident of Azzun in Qalqiliya), Khaled Al-Arraj (A resident of Magharat Al-Dab’a village in Qalqiliya), Saed Al-Assad (A resident of Izbit Al-Ashqar village in Qalqiliya), Raed Tarfa (A resident of Qalqiliya), Sari Mahmoud (A resident of Beit Furiq in Nablus) as they were on a hunting trip near Faroush and Beit Dajjan villages. • Settler Violence: At 01:55, Israeli settlers stormed the east area of Burin village, stoned a home owned by Nael Al-Zaban then withdrew at 02:25.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 22:50.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Khader. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the North entrance of Taqou' until 22:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Za'tara village, demolished a concrete wall surrounding a plot of agricultural land for allegedly being built without a licence and confiscated a caravan with construction equipment owned by Khalaf Al-Himari then withdrew at 09:25. (ii) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Harmala and Khirbeit Al-Dir villages , demolished 2 homes (under construction) owned by Musa Salem Musa and Mohammad Dabash.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ula and stormed a home. (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Dura until 01:55 (iv) At 04:20. Israeli forces raided Halhul, stormed a home and summoned Mohammad Al-Luwali (A Civil Defence force officer) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:30. • Temporary Detention: At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Mohammad Burqan (13 years old) then released him at 01:35. • Attack: On the evening of August 13th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were participating a funeral for alleged stoning and as a result left several; residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Assault on Places of Worship: Since 22:00 on August 12th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Ibrahimi Mosque compound in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from conducting evening prayers in order to allow Israeli settlers to conduct Talmudic rituals inside the mosque.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces detained 4 unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel from east Gaza city
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
