JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> On August 14th 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba’ junction and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 14th 2014, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained a resident. (ii) At dawn on August 14th 2014, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained a resident. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Anata, Shu’fat checkpoint and in Al-Tur neighbourhood, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 14th 2014 Israeli forces detained 37 residents after storming several homes in Jerusalem neighbourhoods (in addition to those mentioned in the previous report) : Muhammad Ali Sarhan (17 years old) Jamal Mahmoud Ghaith (16 years old), Mohammad Amir

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara Bridge. (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illu village until 02:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Kharbith Al-Misbah village, stormed and searched a home, took photographs of several homes then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 04:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shuqba village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Jenin. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Faqou'a village, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 07:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ali Mohammad Abu Salim. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

	for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) Since August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evni Heves” settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road, which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 10:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid until 23:45. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Safarin village stormed a home, confiscated surveillance camera footage from a home owned by Fathi Abdallah Sa’ed. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:30 on August 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusoun and detained Jamal Abdel-Rahman Qa’dan and summoned two residents: Thaer Mohammad Mahmoud Raba’ya and Qussay Bassam Abu Safa to report too Israeli intelligence for questioning.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 14:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near “Tsufit” settlement detained Khaled Abdel-Aziz Daoud for allegedly attempting to enter Israel without a valid permit. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:30 and again at 16:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’ tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Salfit until 12:30. • <u>Raids:</u> At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and detained four residents then withdrew vat 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four residents: Ashraf Mu’beid, Abdel-Qadder Suliman, Muhanad Abu Faris and Mohammad Abu Faris in Deir Istiya.

(ii) At 06:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 07:35.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 24:00 on August 13th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease fire for a period of 120 hours until 24:00 on August 13th 2014 where this period expired and was renewed the extension of the cease fire for an additional 5 days (120 hours) beginning from 24:00 on August 13th 2014.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients. • <u>Killing:</u> On August 14th 2014, Palestinian Medical unites recovered the body of Ibrahim Ismail Odeh (64 years old) from underneath the rubble of a tunnel destroyed by Israeli airstrikes on the Gaza Strip.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Killing:</u> On August 14th 2014, Muhdiya Al-Mubid (A resident of Al-Shuja'iyah) died of injuries sustained from missile strikes towards Gaza.

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entry of fuel and Humanitarian supplies. • <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of August 14th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah. • <u>Killing:</u> On August 14th 2014, Jihad Ali Abu Zied (61 years old) {A resident of Rafah} died of injuries sustained from missile strikes towards Gaza as he was being treated at a hospital in the Arab Republic of Egypt
