| ALL DISTRICTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beginning on 15 August 2005, the Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure over the district of Jenin and the Gaza Strip and declare them closed military zones. The Israeli army prevented civilians and workers from entering the city of Jerusalem or crossing the Green Line in order to evacuate Israeli settlements in the district of Jenin and evacuate settlements and withdraw from the Gaza Strip.</li> </ul> |

| JERUSALEM           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and in the area surrounding Al Aqsa Mosque compound, preventing civilians under the age of 45 from accessing Al Aqsa Mosque to perform prayers. The Israeli army also used a surveillance balloon, equipped with cameras, to observe worshippers in Al Aqsa Mosque.</li> <li><b>Checkpoints:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya and An Nabi Samwil checkpoints and impede civilian access.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the village of 'Anata checkpoint and prevent civilians from crossing in both directions.</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>Wall Gates:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li><b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, and in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina.</li> <li><b>Raid:</b> The Israeli army raided the village of 'Anata and fired sound and tear gas grenades towards civilians, injuring a number of civilians as a result of tear gas inhalation.</li> <li><b>Settler Violence:</b> A group of Israeli settlers attempted to raid Al Aqsa Mosque compound from Bab as Silsila. Palestinian guards of Al Aqsa Mosque prevented the settlers from entering the compound.</li> </ul> |

The Israeli army also allocated alternate roads, including detour routes, connecting towns and villages to the city of Jenin for civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:35, the Israeli army closed the main entrance to the town of 'Arraba with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) At 11:35, the Israeli army closed the Jenin-Nablus main road, set up a checkpoint on the junction to the town of 'Arraba, and prevented civilians and vehicles from crossing in both directions.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army set up an iron gate in the vicinity of the village of Imreiha south of the town of Ya'bad along the road connecting the districts of Jenin and Tulkarem and denied civilian access in both directions.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and prevent civilians from crossing in both directions.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Curfew:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Arraba.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army raided the village of 'Ein al Beida, set up checkpoints at its entrances, and imposed curfew.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |
