Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the (ii) area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit (ii) Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya **JERUSALEM** checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. Raid: At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 16:00. **Detention:** At 16:20, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shalabi in the old city of Jerusalem. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu (i) Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet El" settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. Flying Checkpoint: At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Ofra" **RAMALLAH &** settlement located at the entrance of Silwad until 14:15. AL BIREH Raid: (i) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya, stormed a hospital for alleged stoning of an Israeli settler vehicle from the area near the hospital. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Zied village until 02:45. • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Tagou'until 11:50.
- (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara.
- (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 20:15.
- (iv) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khader bridge until 22:10.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar until 13:40.
- (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village and summoned Ahmad Al-Shiekh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iii) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Husan village, detained 2 residents after storming and searching their homes then withdrew at 05:20.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Za'oul and Mohammad Hamarat in Husan village.
- Attack: At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

BETHLEHEM

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiva village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds.

Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou'.
- (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar
- (iii) At 23:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar and detained a resident.
- (iv) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron.
- (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fah's area located in South Hebron.

Raid:

- (i) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed and searched 2 homes summoned 2 residents: Khaled Amro and Mohammad Amro to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:00.
- (ii) At dawn on August 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron and summoned Faraj Abu Skhiedum to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Khalil Abu Mariya (A resident of Beit Ummar).
- **Demonstration:** At 11:00, , a demonstration took place near "Beit Al-Baraka" hospital in Al-Urub camp protesting against the Israeli Authorities decision to demolish the hospital confiscate the land and build a settlement project on the site during which Israeli forces prevented protestors from reaching the demonstration site and declares the area a closed military zone.

HEBRON

ALL DISTRICTS • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Central Gaza • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. Attack: On the morning of August 16th 2015, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in east Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: On the morning of August 16th 2015Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Al-Buriej and Al-Maghazi camps.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
