ALL DISTRICTS	<ul> <li>Beginning on 15 August 2005, the Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure over the district of Jenin and the Gaza Strip and declare them closed military zones. The Israeli army prevented civilians and workers from entering the city of Jerusalem or crossing the Green Line in order to evacuate 4 Israeli settlements in the district of Jenin and evacuate settlements and withdraw from the Gaza Strip.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li><u>Destruction of Property</u>: The Israeli army levelled a playground in the village of 'Anata, claiming that it is located on the Wall route.</li> <li><u>Settler Violence</u>: A group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Neve Ya'akov threw stones at civilian vehicles travelling in the vicinity of Dahiyat al Bareed checkpoint in the city of Jerusalem.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li><u>Land Levelling</u>: At 14:00, the Israeli army levelled approximately 15 dunums (3.75 acres) of land cultivated with olive trees in the area between the villages of Burqa and Bizzariya south of the settlement of Homesh, slated for evacuation.</li> <li><u>Settler Violence</u>: At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers seized control of 2 uninhabited houses at the western entrance to the village of Burqa.</li> </ul>
SALFIT	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close the main northwestern entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising).</li> <li>Checkpoints: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various times in the morning, impeding civilian movement.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, preventing civilians from crossing.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat near the Green Line, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the villages of Marda and Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoint: At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Haris and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</li> <li>At 08:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of 'Ammuriya.</li> <li>At 11:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the towns of Jamma'in and Deir Istiya.</li> <li>At 18:15, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Salfit, took position near 1 Palestinian National Security location, and took photographs of the location. At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area until 23:50.</li> <li>Land Levelling: On 15 August 2005, the Israeli army levelled land in the vicinity of the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Deir Ballut in order to expand the checkpoint.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: At 08:10, the Israeli army sealed off the city of Jericho, declared it a closed military zone, and prevented civilians from entering or exiting the city until 11:30.</li> <li>Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus, impeding civilian access.</li> <li>House Demolition Notices: The Israeli army distributed notices to demolish a number of houses in the village of Al Jiftlik, claiming that they were built without the required licences.</li> </ul>

#### Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man, in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers civilians' residence in the village illegal. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala. Flying Checkpoint: At 17:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along the road to the town of Tuqu' and arrested 1 Palestinian National **BETHLEHEM** Security officer. **Raid:** At 00:45, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Bethlehem, set up a checkpoint in the vicinity of Ad Duheisha refugee camp, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. Arrest: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up along the road to the town of Tuqu' arrested Ibrahim Mohammed ash Sha'er, a Palestinian National Security officer. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh in the H2 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks and barbed wire, denying civilians and vehicles access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shallala old and new streets in the H1 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks located 300 meters inside the H1 section. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and as Samoa'. Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along Road # 60 near Zif junction south of the city of Hebron and searched civilians **HEBRON** and vehicles. **Raids/Destruction of Property:** At 09:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Idhna and demolished 3 barracks, 1 sheep pen, and 1 water well, claiming that they were built without the required licenses. At 09:30, Israeli troops, dispatched from Israeli army helicopters, (ii) raided and combed the area south of the town of Adh Dhahiriya. At 23:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. (iii) The Israeli army raided the town of Yatta and the village of Al Karmil, (iv) set up checkpoints in the centres of the town and village, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. Land Levelling: The Israeli army levelled agricultural land in the area of Al Buweira in the city of Hebron for construction of a wall around the settlement of Harsina.

RAFAH	<ul> <li>Closure of Roads and Crossing Points:         <ul> <li>Yasser Arafat International Airport remains closed.</li> <li>Rafah Crossing is closed to Palestinian civilians under the age of 35.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Al Mawasi/Rafah road is closed.</li> </ul>

- (iv) Sufa Crossing is closed.
  - Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:
- (i) At 14:00, Israeli troops positioned in Tall Zu'rub military post along the Egyptian border opened fire towards Palestinian territory in Rafah refugee camp.
- (ii) At 24:00, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 7 along the Egyptian border towards Palestinian territory in the area surrounding Salah ad Din gate.
- <u>Arrest</u>: At 19:10, Israeli troops positioned at Rafah Crossing arrested Sumayyah Mazid, a female civilian, while she was returning form Egypt. Mazid's 4 children were permitted to cross.

#### **GENERAL**

#### Gaza Strip: (i) Israeli authorities cancelled previously-issued access permits and issued special permits for workers to work inside the Green Line during the current closure. (ii) Israeli authorities renewed 664 work permits for workers to enter the Industrial Zones. However, only 227 workers (approximately 34.2% of **WORK** those possessing work permits) were allowed access to the Industrial **PRMITS** Zones. Israeli authorities renewed 188 work permits for workers to cross the (iii) Green Line. However, only 37 workers (approximately 19.7% of those possessing work permits) were allowed access to areas inside the Green Line. Israeli authorities issued permits for 51 workers from the Gaza Strip to (iv) stay overnight inside the Green Line.
