### WEST BANK

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

# • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Esawiya village and clashed with several residents.

# • Attack:

- (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a child.
- (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shu'fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mus'ab Hijazi (17 years old) at Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

### • Raid:

- (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village stormed a merchant shop and surveyed surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 01:30.
- (ii) At 04:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwarat village and detained a resident.
- **Detention:** Israeli detained Mu'tasim Amjad Abu Ramis in Al-Shuwarat village
- <u>Attack:</u> At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and confrontations occurred again at 18:00.

# • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

# • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

### Flying Checkpoint:

(i) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabun area located in north Hebron.

(ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Amrat, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 13:00.
- (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Safaa village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 06:00.

# • Attack:

- (i) At 19:05, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Huwar area junction located in north Halhul fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at Khursa village junction fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 18:40, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Maher Abu Haya near Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron after assaulting him.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporally detained the child Firas Yacoub Al-Natsheh (11 years old) then released him at 21:10.

# • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 17:50, Israeli settlers stormed Khuzq Al-Far area in the old city of Hebron and provoked residents.
- (ii) At 18:40, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron, assaulted several residents during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# ALL DISTRICTS • At 24:00 on August 13<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease fire for a period of 120 hours until 24:00 on August 13<sup>th</sup> 2014 where this period expired and was renewed the extension of the cease fire for an additional 5 days (120 hours) beginning from 24:00 on August 13<sup>th</sup> 2014.

# Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients. Attack: On the morning of August 17th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-**NORTHERN GAZA** fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in Beit Lahiya. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January **GAZA** 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Killing: On the evening of August 16th 2014, Hiba Abdel-Al (A resident of Al-Sabra neighbourhood in Gaza) died at a hospital in Jerusalem of injuries sustained from missile strikes towards Gaza.
