• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Dahiyat Al-Bareed area in Al-Ram.
- **Raid:** At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Hizma, stormed and searched a home.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 06:00, Israeli forces demolished 11 apartments on implementation of a court order that the home were allegedly built on land owned by the Israeli government despite the fact that the owners have been living in it since 1967 but have been residing in the United States of America).
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of August 18th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked several worshipers under the protection of Israeli forces.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers stormed Mikhmas village and assaulted Najah Abu Ali, a resident of Mikhmas village using a steel pipe as he was herding

- Raid: At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Nur Al-Shams camp, stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 05:25.
- Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

Closure of Roads:

- Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of (i) Azzun town.
- In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, (ii) the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Oaddum village.

Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyus and Kafr
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun.

Raid:

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Jit village, served halt to construction orders for 10 homes owned by Billal Sada, Odeh Omran, Khalid Omran, Mohammad AlSada, Eyad Yamen, Tamer Yamen, Jamal Abu Bakr, Baha Abu Baker, Sidiq Abu Bakr and Hikmat Yamen for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village and clashed with its residents.
- (iii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with residents as they stormed several merchant shops, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 05:55.

Detention: Israeli forces detained Murad Abu Shhab, Mu'tasim Shawar and Abdel Rahman Khadija in Qalqiliya.

Physical Assault: At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near " Oranite" settlement assaulted and injured 2 residents: Ahmad Abu Daga (broken foot), a resident of Tulkarem and Ahmad Assad (broken hand), resident of Jerusalem.

Wall Gates:

- The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to (i) search civilians, including students, using a metal detector and at 08:00 Israeli forces closed the main entrance then reopened it at a later time.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

Wall Construction:

(i) Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah and Ayda camp, clashed with residents and then withdrew at 15:00.
- (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with its residents and as a result suffocated member of Khalil Harats family from tear gas inhalation after Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades into their home.
- (iii) At dawn on August 19th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Ubidiya, detained a resident and summoned Yahya Atta to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Assa in Al-Ubidiya.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: On August 18th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Khadr and seized a plot of land approximately 2 dunumes (acres) owned by Adnan Abu Zayed and installed a steel fence around the plot of land.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• <u>Closure:</u>

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khursa village junction.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar, seized a Police patrol vehicle then allowed it to pass through at a later time.

• Raid:

- (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Yatta and stormed a home.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched the Islamic Charity organization.
- (iii)At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed and searched a home.
- (iv)At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa area in south Dura, detained 2 residents as they stormed their homes.
- (v) At 04:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a resident as they stormed a home.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Yunis Abu Ras and Arif Haribat in Dura.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Anwar Khamis in Beit Ummar.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 07:15 on August 18th 2013, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ramadin village opened fire towards a vehicle carrying several labours as they attempted to enter Israeli and as a result damaged the vehicles tires.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November ALL 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 DISTRICTS re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **NORTHERN Detention:** *As mentioned in the previous report the names of 3 unidentified GAZA individuals who were detained while swimming off the shores of Beit Lahiya have been identified as Mahmoud Tawfiq, Abdel Karim Mahmoud and Mahmoud Abu Hamliya all residents of Gaza. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, (ii) the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **Closure of Crossing Points:** Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of **RAFAH** critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel, construction material for Internationally funded projects and

allowed 20 truckloads of humanitarian goods.
