JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> On August 18th 2014, Israeli forces detained 3 residents including a child: Omar Hassan Al-Firawi (16 years old), Thaer Assaliya and Mohammad Abu Sneieneh in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ni’lin. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed a merchant shop then withdrew at 15:30. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Abboud, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 14:30. (iii) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents and again at 18:00 clashed with residents then withdrew at 19:30. (iv) At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Budrus village, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 19:35. (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided N’ilin, opened fire towards Mohammad Fadil Ibrahim Al-Masri as they apprehended him and as a result injured him his leg then withdrew at 23:10 (vi) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed two homes then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Budrus village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On August 17th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed Nab’e Al-Ma area in Dura Al-Qar’e and set fire to a storage room owned by Wael Ahmad Sha’ban and spray painted racist graffiti in Hebrew.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Anza village and clashed with several residents. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Far’a camp, stormed several homes, detained nine residents including a child then withdrew at 07:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:15, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint detained Mohammad Salah Aliyan (A resident of Al-Far’a camp). (ii) Israeli forces detained nine residents: Wael Fathi Mansour (17 years old), Muthfir Mohammad Nayef Al-Shafi’I, Oday Hassan Al-Taliya, Hassan Bassam Al-Taliya, Abdel-Rahman Fathi Mansour, Akram Fathi Mansour, Haytham Fathi Mansour, Samir Zuhier Sawalmeh and Saqr Mohammad Nayef Al-Shafi’I in Al-Far’a camp.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) Since August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evni Heves” settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages then withdrew at 08:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30 on August 18th 2014, Israeli forces raided Quffin, stormed seven homes, temporarily detained its residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Shwakiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, detained a resident then with at 05:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Imad Abdallah Mohammad Abdou in raided Shwakiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned near wall gate (456) located in Zieta fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, and stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Jit village until 12:30. (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Yunis village and detained a resident. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:20. (iv) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Baqat Al-Hattab village temporarily detained the child: Hamoudeh Ahmad Abdel-Karim (14 years old) then released him at later time. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Musa Mohammad Sa’id Radwan in Al-Nabi Eliyas village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Nur Al-Din Mohammad Qassim Ahmad in Qalqiliya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle in Beita then reopened it at 23320. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 14:35. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Subustiya and detained a resident. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Madma village junction until 22:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces raided Yatma village, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officer then withdrew at 09:45. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Qabalan, stormed and searched a storage room, temporarily detained Saber Suliman Jamal Al-Arouri (A resident of Awrata in Ramallah) then released him at a later time and withdrew at 13:40. (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Beita. (iv) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Burqa village, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 04:15. (v) At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed two homes, detained a residents then withdrew at 05:10. <p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:55, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Amid Nasr-Al-Din Mufdi and Tahrir Nasr-Al-Din Mufdi {who suffers of a psychological disorder} (residents of Nablus) as they were returning from Jordan then released them at a later time. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers driving vehicle stormed Northeast Jericho city and opened fire towards a waste truck owned by the Municipality of Jericho as they were removing waste from the area.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-' Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
