JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mustafa Al-Kharouf. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma, stormed two homes and detained a resident. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Anata then stormed and searched a home. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:00 on August 19th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Khan Al-Hamra area detained Salman Al-Khatib (A resident of Hizma). (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces detained Layth Abed Rabbo in Beit Hanina. (iii) On the morning of August 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained Munir Mahmoud (A resident of Al-Eisawiya village). (iv) On August 19th 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents: Abdallah Al-Sinjlawi, Samer Abu Eishah and Anan Najib in the old city of Jerusalem. 	<p>(vi) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Khatib in Hizma village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Salaseh gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem detained Tallal Al-Rajabi (70 years old) then released him later. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained three girls: Asma Abu Madi (13 years old), Nour Al-Safadi (13 years old) and Isra' Abu Wahdan (13 years old) then released them later. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad Abdel Latif in the old city of Jerusalem then released him after making him pay a fine mounting to 5000 NIS and imposed a sentence of 5 days house arrest. (iv) On August 19th 2015, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Yusef Al-Shawish (14 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem then released him after serving him a military order preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 15 days. • <u>Expulsion:</u> At 23:00, Israeli authorities served a military order to Khadja Owies (A resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood) preventing her from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 15 days after she was released as she was detained in Al-Aqsa mosque compound as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 13:00, a group of Israeli settler under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, an Israeli settler disguised as an Arab resident stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound during which mosque guards were able to remove him from the area. (ii) At 22:30, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted an unidentified resident in Jerusalem leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Habala, summoned 3 residents: Ahmad Mardawi, Mohammad Attal and Mohammad Al-Jada' to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 12:45. (ii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village, stormed several homes, detained three residents and summoned two residents: Mansour Subhi (14 years old) and Basahar Ishtewi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Sari Barham (17 years old), Mohammad Aqel and Mahmoud Ishtewi in Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned in east Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u>

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
