<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to Jerusalem City and to prevent civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, except those holding special permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance Al-Esawiyah town, searching civilians and vehicles until 15:30</li> <li>• <b><u>Detentions:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At noon on August 20th 2011, Israeli forces detained the civilian Nidal A’qil in Al-Samara in area between Shiekh Jarah and Shoa’fat camp in Jerusalem..</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 13:20, a group of Israeli settlers from “ Koghaf Yacoub” settlement severely beat and injured the child, Bassam Dahoud Hussien Al Hathlin, as he was tending to his sheep in Mikhmas village . He was later transported to a nearby hospital with contusions.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim because of Jewish Sabbath holiday.</li> </ul>
<b>RAMALLAH &amp;</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban</li> </ul>

<b>AL BIREH</b>	Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages because of Jewish Sabbath holiday.
<b>JENIN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Road:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Masliya village</li> <li>(ii) At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Al Jabirat area in Jenin.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.</li> </ul>
<b>TUBAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:00 Israeli forces raided an area between Aqaba town and Al Kaffir village.</li> <li>(ii) At 21: 30, Israeli forces raided Al Farisiya village until 23:30.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road, impeding the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying checkpoints:</b> At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on Al Kafriyat road (the main road connecting Tulkarem &amp; Qalqilya) searching civilians &amp; vehicles..</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route was suspended in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village because of Jewish Sabbath holiday.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:10 and again at 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 10:15 and again at 21:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Kafr Lafiq village, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Izbat Al-Tabib village, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(iv) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Hijja village, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(v) At 03:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Al Jit village, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> At 15:50, Israeli forces raided Jinsafut village.</li> <li>• <b>Settler violence:</b> At 23:00, a group of Israeli settlers stoned civilian vehicles along the Qalqilya – Nablus main road.</li> <li>• .</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b></li> </ul> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was suspended in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement because of Jewish Sabbath holiday.</li> </ul>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b></li> </ul> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to restrict times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:</li> </ul> <p>(i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood.</p> <p>(ii) At ‘Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.</p> <p>(iii) At 08:55, Israeli forces increased restriction on civilian movement on Huwara checkpoint, impeding the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Flying checkpoints:</b></li> </ul> <p>(i) At 10:20 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village.</p> <p>(ii) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Salem village, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(iii) At 10:55 and again at 21:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction North of Huwara town, searching civilians and vehicles</p> <p>(iv) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Furik village.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(v) At 14:20 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qablan village, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(vi) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Sura village (on the main road connecting Nablus &amp; Qalqilya), searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(vii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near the villages of Talouza and Al Bathaan, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(viii) At 01:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al Bathaan road (located on the northern entrance of Nablus city) searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ix) At 01:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the Deir Sharaf junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> At 23:30, Israeli forces raided a neighbourhood located north of Nablus city during which confrontations ensued between Israeli forces and residents</li> </ul>
<b>SALFIT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds and cement blocks the northern entrance to Bruqin town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(iii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> At 23:00, Israeli forces intensified restrictions on Zatara checkpoint, obstructing the free flow of traffic and detained 2 civilians.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Dier Ballout and Rafat villages, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Bidya town until 01:40.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction has resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Road:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al 'Auja village with cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. And from 23:20 to 23:50, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint while searching the surrounding area.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces continue to restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-'Auja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at at the junction of Al-Jiftliq village, searching civilians and vehicles</li> <li>(ii) At 04:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho, searching civilians and vehicles until 05:00</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israeli army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi ,Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> At 22:00, Israeli forces increased restrictions on civilian movement at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:40 and again at 07:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Dar Salah village on the eastern entrance of Biet Sahour, searching civilians and vehicles..</li> <li>(ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the northern and southern entrances of Taqo'a village</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:35, Israeli forces raided Hussan village and fired flash grenades in the area, detained 3 minors and temporarily detained 16 year old Mohammad Marzouq Saleh.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al Khadir town until 02:35</li> <li>(iii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Dheisheh camp in Bethlehem, opened fire on civilians while searching homes, injuring a civilian; forces withdrew at 03:50</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Detentions:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces detained 3 minors during their raid into Al-Khader town: 16 year-old Mohammad Marzouq Saleh, 16 year-old Abdallah Abbas Marzouq Saleh and 15 year-old Amjad Ratib A'mran Saleh.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained 2 civilains during a raid into Al-Dheisheh refugee camp: Badir Izhaq Badrin (who was injured in the raid) and Usayed Abdel Majid Atta A'marna</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was suspended northwest of Beit Jala town because of Jewish Sabbath holiday.</li> </ul>
<b>Hebron</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
    - (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up four (4) flying checkpoints at the entrances of Biet Kahel town at the Fawar junction, searching civilians and vehicles.
    - (ii) At 16:30 and again at 24:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the bridge leading to Halhoul town, searching civilians and vehicles.
    - (iii) At 17:20 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Younis (located on Hebron –Bethlehem main road), searching civilians and vehicles.
    - (iv) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Al-Tabaqa village and fired sound grenades towards civilians near Al jabir area.
    - (v) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Souba village, searching civilians and vehicles.
    - (vi) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna town, searching civilians and vehicles.
    - (vii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fawar Camp and prevented civilians and vehicles from entering or exiting the camp.
    - (viii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance Al Ramadin village, searching civilians and vehicles.
    - (ix) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the northern entrance of Hebron city, searching civilians and vehicles.
  - **Raids:**
    - (i) At 17:05 Israeli forces raided Dura village, during which confrontations ensued between village residents and Israeli forces which led to the injury of the civilian Ahmad Hafith A'mro.
    - (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Khursa village and set up a flying checkpoint.
    - (iii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Surif town and detained 4 civilians.
    - (iv) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Hebron City, searched a number of homes and detained 46 civilians including 4 Security officers.
    - (v) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya town.
    - (vi) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Yatta town.
    - (vii) At 02:00 Israeli forces raided Al-Burj village, searched a number of homes, detained 10 civilians and served 4 civilians with summons to report to Israeli Intelligence: including: Mohammad Salim Al Haribat, Salim Mohammad Haribat, Raid Mohammad Haribat and Murad Mohammad Haribat.
    - (viii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou'a village, firing sound grenades searched a number of houses and withdrew at 03:30
    - (ix) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Biet Ula and searched a home.
    - (x) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Biet A'wa town and detained 4 civilians.
    - (xi) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Ithna town and detained a Palestinian Legislative Council Member.
    - (xii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta town and detained 2 civilians.

(xiii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Khursa village .

(xiv) At 04: 20, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'eim village.
