- (iii)At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:00.

### • Detention:

- (i) At 16:55, Israeli forces detained Munjid Fihmi Ahmad Hamarat (A resident of Husan village) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Yasser Mohammad Ahmad Sbatin (17 years old) and Mohammad Sami Abdel-Hamid Hamarah in Husan village.

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

# • At 24:00 on August 13<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease fire for a period of 120 hours until 24:00 on August 13<sup>th</sup> 2014 where this period expired and was renewed the extension of the cease fire for an additional 5 days (120 hours) beginning from 24:00 on August 13<sup>th</sup> 2014 and the cease was renewed on August 18<sup>th</sup> 2014 for a period of 24 hours which was broken after 8 hours of implementation.

- Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 100 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah which increases the number of airstrikes launched to 7498 since the Israeli Military assault on the Gaza Strip and as a result killed 25 residents including 7 children, 3 woman and 2 Elderly residents which increases the number of civilians killed to 2061 and injured 84 residents {which increases the number of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 10220 including 3103 children and 2061 Women and 85 homes were demolished in the Gaza strip which increases the number of homes demolished to 14649 including 2108 completely destroyed and 12541 partially destroyed.
- Israeli missiles strikes partially destroyed **two** mosques, which increases the total number of mosques destroyed to **141** {including **48** destroyed and **93** partially destroyed since the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza Strip.
- Israeli missile strikes destroyed an ambulance, which increases the total number of Ambulances destroyed to **16** since the Israeli Military assault on the Gaza Strip.
- Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching **107** projectiles.

- (v) At 21:15, Israeli fighter jets launched a missile towards several residents in Tawam area located west Beit Lahiya and as a result killed two residents.
- (vi)At 06:45, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles Abu Jasser family home in Al-Qassassib area in west Jabaliya camp and as a result killed a resident.
- (vii)At 07:50, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles towards several residents in Al-Atarah area in Beit Lahiya and as a result killed two residents including a woman and a child.
