JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since August 21st 2011 the Israeli army restricted access at checkpoints located at the entrances to Jerusalem City and to prevent civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, except those holding special permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On the evening of August 21st 2011, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions on Jaba’ checkpoint (the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah & Jericho) and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance Al-Esawiyah town, searching civilians and vehicles until 18:00 • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces physically assaulted 2 civilians including a minor, 17 year-old Abdel Hamid Khamis Al-Titi & Kamal Fayeze Al-A’draba • <u>Obstruction of Access to Places of Worship:</u> On the evening of August 21st 2011, Israeli forces closed down 2 main doors of Al Aqsa Mosque Compound, in addition to closing the main gates leading to the Old City. Demonstrations erupted to protest the Israeli aggression on Gaza, during which confrontations took place; 4 medical paramedics were injured and a civilian was detained. • <u>Detentions:</u> Israeli forces detained Musa Mohammad Abdel Wahad at the entrance of the Old City. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs

	<p>to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:45, an Israeli settler vehicle struck the civilian Ahmad Sami Tawafsha, severely injuring him. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles, seriously damaging Jamal Abu Fakhdiya's vehicle. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces raided A'tara village (ii) At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Jabloun village until 22:45. (iii) At 2:15, Israeli forces raided the Jenin refugee camp, opened fire as they searched homes and detained 4 civilians; severely beat an intelligence officer and destroyed property then withdrew at 03:30. • Detentions: Israeli forces detained 4 civilians during their raid into the Jenin refugee camp: Mohammad Ibrahim Naghanghiya, Mamoun Hassan Gharib, Ziyad Ahmad Gharib and Samih Ahmad Gharib. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: At 10:20, Israeli army stepped up restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road, impeding the free flow of traffic. • Flying checkpoints: At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Bazaria village, east of Anabta . • Raid: At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Biet Lid village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Jinsafut village. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Izbat Al-Tabib village. (iii) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Azzun town, searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Azzoun A’tma village, fired live ammunition and flash grenades as they chased after labourers trying to pass through wall gate to work in Israel. • <u>Settler violence:</u> At 11:30, a group of Israeli settlers stoned civilian vehicles along the Qalqiya-Nablus main road, damaging Iyad Adnan Milhim’s vehicle. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood. (ii) At ‘Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. (iii) At 15:35, Israeli forces increased restriction on civilian movement on Huwara checkpoint, impeding the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying checkpoints:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the Deir Sharaf junction, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 23:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Arqaba and Majdal Alnabi Fadil villages. (iii) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of A'warta villag , searching civilians and vehicles (iv) At 01:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of A'sira Al-Shamalia village. • Settler Violence: At dawn on August 21st 2011, a group of Israeli settlers uprooted approximately 70 Olive trees belonging to the civilians Rabi' Abu Baker, Samir Hassan & Jabali Abu Riyda in Qasri village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds and cement blocks the northern entrance to Bruqin town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (iii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to increase restrictions on Zatara checkpoint, obstructing the free flow of traffic and detained 2 civilians. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Dier Ballout and Rafat villages, detained a number of civilians and withdrew at 15:35. • Wall Construction: Wall construction has resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al 'Auja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. And from 23:20 to 23:50, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint while searching the surrounding area. (ii) Israeli forces continue to restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-'Auja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Fasayil village, searching civilians and vehicles (ii) At 04:45 and again at 05:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho, searching civilians and vehicles until 06:05. (iii) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al-Jiftliq village, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 01:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near A'in Dweik village on the northern entrance of Jericho city, searching civilians and vehicles

	until 02:40.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israeli army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi ,Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Checkpoints: At 08:00, 15:30 and 20:50, Israeli forces increased restrictions on civilian movement at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 19:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Dar Salah village on the eastern entrance of Biet Sahour, searching civilians and vehicles until 20:00. (ii) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Al Nashash on the southern entrance of Bethlehem, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou village, searching civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 05:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint beneath Al-khadir village's bridge, searching civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Raakaba area in Al-Khadir village and set up a flying checkpoint. . • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to

(iv) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahiriya town searching civilians and vehicles. Israeli forces also set up 3 flying checkpoints and beat the civilian Rami Al-Falah, leaving him with contusions.. • At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriah village. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 00:40, Israeli forces located on the junction of Al Nabi Younis area (located on the Hebron-Bethlehem road) and beat the civilian Nabil Saleem Karajeh from Halul village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:45, an Israeli settler vehicle over ran 12 year-old Najah Abu Ramelih, leaving her severely injured near the Ibrahim mosque. (ii) At 23:55, a group of Israeli settlers physically assaulted a number of civilians near Wadi Al-Nies area in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on at 21:00 on August 21st 2011. • Ceasefire violations: Israeli forces violated the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Rafah; Israeli fighter jets launched 8 missiles at targets in northern Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Younis and Rafah, injuring 11 civilians, including 2 children and 3 Palestinian gunmen. Armed Palestinians launched 54 projectiles, including 13 Grad missiles towards the Green Line. • On August 21st 2011, Israeli helicopters and surveillance planes flew over Gaza,
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is open to previously-coordinated critically ill civilians, foreign journalists, International Organization staff, merchants, business people and civilians travelling to Jordan through Al-Karama (Allenby) Bridge in the West Bank. • <u>Aerial Assaults:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of August 21st 2011, unmanned Israeli drones fired 1 missile, critically injuring a child near Biet Lahia. (ii) At 19:40, an unmanned Israeli aircraft fired 2 missiles towards armed Palestinian individuals, injuring a Palestinian gunman near Beit Lahiya. (iii) At 23:00, unmanned Israeli drones fired missiles at a vehicle near the American school in Biet Lahia, destroying the vehicle. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, armed Palestinians fired 1 Grad missile towards the Green Line. (ii) At 12:05, armed Palestinians fired 1 Grad missile towards the Green Line. (iii) At 16:40, armed Palestinians fired projectiles towards the Green Line.
