(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

 - (iii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction until 23:00.

 - (i) At 03:00 on August 21st 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained 3 residents including a child.
 - (ii) At 04:00 on August 21st 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and detained two residents.
 - (iii) At 06:00 on August 21st 2014, Israeli forces raided Ithna and detained a resident.
 - (iv) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 00:30.
 - (v) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', clashed with residents as they stormed a home, detained a PLC member then withdrew at 05:00.

 - (iii) Israeli forces detained Na'im Mohamad Bashir.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Bassam Ahmad Musa Al-Za'arir (A PLC member).
 - **Temporary Detention:** At 10:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained 40 residents near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron then released them at 11:30.

 - (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron fired stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Ziyad Adnan Hassan Tabish (17 years old).
 - **Settler Violence:** At 19:10, an Israeli settler placed and detonated a UXO inside of a water well in Sa'ir village and as a result injured Zidan Ahmad Issa Shaladah (A sheppard).

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 24:00 on August 13th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease fire for a period of 120 hours until 24:00 on August 13th 2014 where this period expired and was renewed the extension of the cease fire for an additional 5 days (120 hours) beginning from 24:00 on August 13th 2014 and the cease was renewed on August 18th 2014 for a period of 24 hours which was broken after 8 hours of implementation. • Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line broke the cease-fire agreement by launching tank artillery shells towards the Gaza Strip. • Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 60 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 25 residents including 7 children which increases the number of civilians killed to 2086 and injured 262 residents {which increases the number of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 10482. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 68 projectiles.
