WEST BANK

Closure: (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the (ii) area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit (ii) Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Oalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another **JERUSALEM** for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Jericho and Ramallah and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it later. Flying Checkpoint: At 01:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Raid: At 15:50 and again at 01:05, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, stormed several Jewellery shops until 02:25. Attack: At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning of a settler vehicle. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-(ii) Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. **Closure of Main Roads: RAMALLAH &** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Oumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Danivvel" (ii) settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Tagou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement
- Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iii)
- Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area (iv) in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and (v) road 60 with dirt mounds.
- Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to (vi) 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with (vii)
- On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of (viii) Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marah Rabah village until 20:50.

Raid:

- (i) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Tagou', stormed and searched several homes and summoned 2 residents: Jamal Hamid and Mohammad Al-Badan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:45.
- (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village and summoned Abdel-Kareem Al-Sheikh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:50.
- **Attack:** At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Wadi Al-Hums area located in North Bethlehem fired stun grenades towards several labourers attempting to climb the wall gate in order to work in Jerusalem and as a result injured Salah Khalif and Saher Khalif leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **Demonstration:** On the morning of August 22nd 2015, a demonstration took place in B'ir Ona area in Beit Jallah protesting against the levelling of land in order to construct the wall.

BETHLEHEM

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds.

HEBRON

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron until 14:00.
- (ii) At 16:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Wadi Sa'ir road until 17:00.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar (for the alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle) then withdrew later.
- Raid: At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed two homes and detained two residents.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yusef Baraghith and Mahmoud Baragith in Beit Ummar.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Central Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. Attack: On the morning of August 23rd 2015, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach located in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<u>Attack:</u> On the morning of August 23 rd 2015, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Al-Nussirat camp beach
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
