JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired live ammunition towards several residents (for alleged shooting incidents towards Israeli forces on the checkpoints and injured an Israeli soldier).
 - (iii) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned at Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Abdel-Aziz Badr leaving him hospitalised.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 12:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra’a Al-Gharbiya and stormed a home. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Tariq Fayad and Yassin Faraj in Ramallah. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned between Abboud and Deir Abu Mash’al village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Safaa village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Taysir Salah Abdel-Rahim Abdel-Karim (16 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shuqba fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. <p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 24:00 on August 10th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a temporary cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) to cease fire for a period of 120 hours until 24:00 on August 13th 2014 where this period expired and was renewed the extension of the cease fire for an additional 5 days (120 hours) beginning from 24:00 on August 13th 2014 and at 24:00 on August 18th 2014, Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement 8 hours before the ceasefire expiration . • Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 115 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 14 residents including 6 children, 2 women which increases the number of civilians killed to 2123 and injured 120 residents {which increases the number of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 10870. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 121 projectiles.
