GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRITS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards agricultural land in Central Gaza. Israeli military (F-16) aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching 7 missiles towards North Gaza and Gaza injuring 2 residents. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza, Gaza and Central Gaza Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 2 projectiles towards the Green Line.

Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Attack: (i) At 09:30 on August 25th 2012, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 22:00 on August 25th 2012, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya.
