JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints in Silwan neighbourhood, Wadi Al-Ruba area and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and stormed and searched a home. • <u>Detention:</u> On the evening of August 26th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Daqqaq in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint, fired rubber coated stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on August 22nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Silwad • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:35 on August 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash’al and detained a resident (ii) At 00:500, Israeli forces raided Ramallah city, clashed with several residents as they surrounded and stormed a building then withdrew at 03:00 • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On August 27th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near “Modi’in” settlement detained five residents: Nassim Atef Shaladeh, Mohammad Khalil Shaladeh, Akram Azmi Shaladeh, Hamza Azmi Shaladeh and Ahmad Yusef Shaladeh (All residents of Hebron) for allegedly finding knives in their possession. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hamza Ahmad Daoud Atta in Deir Abu Mash’al. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Ur Al-Tahta village temporarily detained Mohammad Khader (Mentally challenged patient) for alleged stoning of an Israeli Military Jeep near the village then released him at 16:00.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jarba village junction. (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya’bad and near Kfr Qaddun village junction until 10:55. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on August 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed a home and confiscated the Identification Card owned by Hillal Samir Bahran Abdel-Halim. (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces raided Rumana village, stormed a merchant shop, temporarily detained Afif Rami Al-Ahmad and released him later then withdrew at 18:00. (iii) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Taybeh until 19:00. (iv) At 19:20 and again at 02:10, Israeli forces raided Anin village, summoned Mohammad Rajjab Yassin to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning, stormed 2 homes and summoned Imad Wahid Assad Yusef to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:50 • <u>Detention:</u> On August 27th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin detained Sadeq Mohammad Kameel (A

	Palestinian Police Officer).
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of the village Faroun. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Attil until 10:30. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya, Allar and Sayda villages until 11:20. (iii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Nur Al-Shams camp, detained 5 residents then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained five residents: Akram Issam Husien Qa’dan, Samer Kamal Al-Fakhouri, Abdel-Basset Issam Sharitih, Amjad Abu Shafaqa and Qasem Riyad Mohammad Badr Tulkarem and Nur Al-Shams camp.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Habalah tunnel located at the south entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in Jayyus fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:55. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya village located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus, temporarily detained Hassan Zahi Suwan (A National intelligence Officer) and released him at 19:45. (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Madma village. (iii) At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 14:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Burin village, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children and stormed the school principals office and several class rooms for alleged stoning and again at 03:30 Israeli forces stormed Salah Al-Najjar and Ibrahim Amrans (School Principles) homes and damaged their furniture and threatened to detain them if any stoning incidents occurred from the school area, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ghassan Zidan Al-Najjar in Burin village
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Harris and Kafil Harris villages until 20:55. (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Ariel" settlement junction and seized a vehicle owned by Subhi Tahsin Atiya (A National Security Force Officer) and confiscated both his personal and Security force Identification Card.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 09:20.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

(iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou' until 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on August 27th 2014, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained a residents after storming his home. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:30. (iii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Fadi Mohammad Daoud Hamarat in Husan village (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Al-Mughrabi, Imad Ibrahim Dariya and Mohammad Hisham Dariya in Beit Fajjar.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna until 15:20. • Temporary Detention: At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Abdallah Odeh Nassa then released him at 11:30. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near "Karmi Itsur" settmenet located in south Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Shuhada' raod and near Bab Al-Zawiya area in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Sufiyan Marwan Hadib leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:35, Israeli settlers positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron assaulted the child Mohammad Imad Abu Shamsiya (12 years old) and as a result, left he hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 21:30, an Israeli settler opened fire from his vehicle towards two residents: Masa'ud Al-Hamadina and Mohammad Taha as they were passing along the bypass road in east Yatta.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Killing:</u> On the morning of August 27th 2014 Yahya Farhan Ahmad Sarour died of injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes towards his vehicle in Al-Qarrara on August 26th 2014.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
