JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30 on August 28th 2014, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident and assaulted Musa Ahmad Al-Louzi. (ii) At 03:30 on August 28th 2014, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on August 28th 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ibrahim Al-Jamal, Mahmoud Ibrahim Hassouneh and Samer Karim Shihadeh in Shu’fat camp in Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Ahmad Al-Louzi in Kafr Aqab. (iii) Israeli force detained Ibrahim Ismail Nimr in Qalandiya camp. • <u>Killing:</u> At 12:00, an Infant: Hanadi Fahed Abu Sbatin (20 days old) {A resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem} died at a hospital after she suffocated from tear gas inhalation during confrontations between Israeli forces and residents on August 27th 2014.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Za'im village fired live ammunition towards Basil Hussien Qassim Yassin (A residents of Al-Za'im village) and as a result left him hospitalised. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur, Silwan and Al-Thuri neighbourhoods in Jerusalem checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning {After the death of a 20 year old infant from Israeli tear gas fire}. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Shiekh Anbar area near Al-Za'im village in east Jerusalem and demolished 5 barrack's {residential} and 3 livestock barrack's owned by Ahmad Al-Jahalin, Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa, Nayef Al-Sa'di, Khalil Al-Sa'di, Khadr Al-Sa'di and Mohammad Al-Sa'di for allegedly being built without proper licencing. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On August 27th 2014, Israeli authorities approved plans for blue print (68858) for the construction of a school consisting of 12 floors including three underground levels in Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood on Palestinian land occupied in 1967. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Khalid Hani Ahmad (A residents of Atil in Tulkarem) in Jerusalem and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:10 and again at 22:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 00:50. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction until 19:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 05:15, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Barjis Nasr Allah Al-Maher (A resident of Tulkarem) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on prior summon. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned at Jabarah checkpoint detained Munadil Muwafaq Mohammad Majdiya (A resident of Allar) as he was returning home from work inside Israel.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 02:20. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in Jayyus fired rubber collated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 11:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces raided Orif village, clashed with several school children then withdrew at 13:30. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 15:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:50.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa'</p>

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
