JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On August 29th 2014, The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00 on August 29th 2014, Israeli forces raided Qutnah village, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and as a result injured 2 residents : Mohammad Mahoud Hushiyeh and Mohammad Mustafa Hamashneh and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained two residents: Saddam Raed Fayeز Imteir and Wajih Awad. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abdallah Al-Fuqiya in Qutnah village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on August 22nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Silwad • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Silwad junction. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah Bridge located at the north entrance of Bir Zeit until 17:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beitin fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured 3 residents including a journalist: Ali Dar Ali (A journalist), Ahmad Abu Rahmeh and Ismail Abu Rahmeh as well as suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad until 24:00. (ii) At 07:15, Israeli forces raided Maythaloun.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tubas and Tayassir village until 11:10.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village until 23:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum and summoned Raed Abdel-Hamid Ishtewi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Kafr Laqif, stormed several homes and summoned two National Security Forec Officers: Kifah Na'im Shahawneh and Ehab Na'im Shahwneh to report Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Azzun and summoned Tarik Mohammad Muhsien to report Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:15. (iv) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Jayyus. (v) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Jit village. • Attack: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Batal area located in Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • Physical Assault: At 10:25, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate in Azzun Atma village assaulted Mazen Imad Assaf (A resident of Baqa Al-Sharqiya in Tulkarem) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • Demonstration: At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and as a result left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the

	<p>Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Bithan road located at the east entrance of Nablus until 13:45. (ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction, temporarily detained two Palestinian Police officers then released them at 15:35. (iii) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction (located along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya) until 16:35. (iv) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Assirah Al-Shimaliya and Ijnisinya village until 21:05. (v) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Shavi Shamron” settlement junction until 19:30. (vi) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 00:10. • Attack: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at entrance of Beit Furiq fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 00:40.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the

village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 16:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents in Um Al-Rakaba area then withdrew at 18:00.
- (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, summoned 4 residents: Ali Foad Dayriya, Mashour Shaher Dariya, Imad Sami Taqatqa and Ibrahim Jaber Al-Kar to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:25.
- (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Ubidiya, summoned Eyad Suliman Sallamah (A presidential Guard) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:10.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque in the north entrance of Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned at the North entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 18:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aydah camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Demonstration:** At 13:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sara village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented protesters from reaching the demonstration site.

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar until 13:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched two homes and detained two residents. (ii) At 06:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 17:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Hamzah Nassar Abu Hashim and Qassam Ahmad Abu Mariya in Beit Ummar. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents including a child and a woman: Malek Yusef Al-Daudah and Nissrin Fawzi Bahar. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in Arnabah area located in Hahoul then withdrew at 17:20.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Killing:</u> On August 29th 2014, Mohammad Al-Ma'subi (A resident of Gaza) died from injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes towards the Gaza strip.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Palestinian gunmen launched five projectiles towards the Green Line. Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • <u>Killing:</u> On August 29th 2014, Daud Abu Zied (A resident of Rafah) died of injuries sustained from Israeli Airstrikes on the Gaza Strip.
