WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces closed Hizma checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it at 15:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) August 30th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Jerusalem detained Hussein Mohammad Abdallah Hajajha (a resident of Taqou’ in Bethlehem). (ii) Israeli forces detained Kifah Abu Al-Hawa and Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on August 22nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Silwad • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Nathim village until 21:50. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village until 22:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Bir Ziet until 01:00. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Awarat until 03:20. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Zied until 03:15.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near The Arab – American University (on Al-Zabadah road) until 08:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 21:05. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Zabada.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'a camp. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Bayda village, stormed several homes, summoned 8 residents : Salah Tawfiq Mir'I, Shadi Firas Fuqaha, Mahmoud Fayez Abu Matawi', Ibrahim Fayez Abu Matawi', Ahmad Fayez Abu Mataw', Osama Fayez Abu Mataw', Sami Hamdi Fuqaha and Nidal Ali Daraghmeh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, set up a checkpoint, temporarily detained the child Waleed Khalid Sirouji (17 years old), assaulted and injured him then released him and withdrew at 21:45.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Huwarah until 00:50. (ii) At 07:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in North Huwrah and closed the bypass road, impeded the free flow of traffic (for alleged firebombing of a settler vehicle). • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Burin village, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention;</u> Israeli forces detained yasar bashare Qadous from the village of Burin.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafil Harris and Harris village and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 00:50, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut until 01:30.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:55 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:35.

	(ii) At 19:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 20:15.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur) until 22:30. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar, temporarily detained two residents: Aoy's Majed Thawabteh (A security force officer) and Ahmad Majed Thawabteh and released them at a later time then withdrew at 00:55. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Wadi Rahal village, stormed a home and summoned Abdel-Hamid Ibrahim Al-Fawaghrah to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar until 04:25. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 04:25 (iv) At 04:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, detained a Police officer until 06:20. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Bassam Abu Khderir (A Police officer) in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Daod Mohammad Al-Khatib (15 years old) then released him later.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp until 13:20. (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 23:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 12:30. (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Shajjanah village and detained a resident. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna until 03:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp detained 2 residents: Amir Abdel-Ghaffar Al-Khamour and Hassan Nayef Al-Ra'i (ii) Israeli forces detained Iyas Atallah Alawi in Wadi Al-Shajaneh village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at Abu Al-Rish checkpoint in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Halah Hisham Jabr for allegedly finding a knife in her possession then released her later. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned along Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron, attacked Nidal Salhjabs home , temporarily abducted his family members inside the home then withdrew at 12:20 (ii) At 12:05, a group of Israeli settlers stoned resident in the old city of Hebron.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area between 100 to 300 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'ya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
