ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> </ul>

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure:</b> At 11:00, the Israeli army closed the city of Jerusalem completely for a number of hours. The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Additionally, the Israeli army combed the area alongside the apartheid Wall as a result of heated alarms of a suicide attack in the city.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> </li> <li> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Checkpoints:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>At 09:10, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the checkpoint set up near the village of Jaba', and impeded traffic.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> </li> <li> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At 18:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Hizma, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>The Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance of the town of Anata, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> </li> <li> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Wall Gates:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in Dahiyat al-Bareed, Dahiyat al-Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to ‘Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba’ road, the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of al-Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</li> </ul>
<b>RAMALLAH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> At 10:00, the Israeli army closed the checkpoints set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and impeded civilian access.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:35, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Surda, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint between the towns of Deir Dibwan and the village of Ein Yabroud.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the city of al-Bireh and stopped a Palestinian security patrol, searched one house and withdrew at 03:30.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Ein, searched 2 civilian houses, and handed one civilian a notice to report to the Israeli intelligence.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:00, a public march set out, with the participation of international peace activists and supporters, in the village of Bil’in in protest of the apartheid Wall construction. Clashes between the Israeli army and unarmed civilians broke out resulting in the injury of 4 civilians. In addition, a number of civilians were asphyxiated as a result of inhaling tear gas.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:00, a public march set out, with the participation of international peace activists and supporters, in the town of Beit Luqya and the villages of Beit Sira, Beit ‘Ur al-Tahta, Beit ‘Ur al-Foqa, al-Tireh, Safa, and Kharbatha al-Misbah which is located west of Ramallah district, towards the bridge between the villages of Beit ‘Ur al-Tahta and Kharbathah al-Misbah, in protest of the Israeli discriminatory policy that prevents Palestinians from traveling on road #443. Clashes broke out between the Israeli army and unarmed civilians during which the Israeli army fired rubber bullets resulting in the injury of 5 civilians including PLC member Muheeb Awwad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.</li> </ul>

	<p>barricades the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Beer al-Pasha, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Anza, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Silet al-Thahr and the village of Ijja, set up a checkpoint and detained a number of civilians.</li> <li>(ii) At 04:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin and its refugee camp and opened fire indiscriminately during patrol</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.</li> </ul>
<b>TOUBAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayaseer checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.</li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil’s plain; the road to the town of Deir al-Ghusun’s plain; and the entrance to the village of ‘Izbat Abu Khamish.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at ‘Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). At 17:00, the Israeli army denied civilians between the age of 16 and 35 access through the ‘Einav checkpoint.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> At 22:35, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta during which clashes with civilians broke out. The Israeli army withdrew at 23:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun as well as the road that connects the town of ‘Azzun to the village of ‘Izbat at Tabib.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement barricades the entrances to the village of Kfar Qaddoum, Hijjeh, Imatin, Baqa al-Hatab, al-Fundoq, and Izbat al-Tabib that connects them to the main Qalqilya-Nablus road.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of ‘Azzun with an iron gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at the</li> </ul>

	<p>checkpoint that is set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqilya and impede traffic. The Israeli army allowed civilian access only on foot.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances to the towns of Azzun, and the villages of Kafr Laqif and Kafr Droum.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:50, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village of Jit, and fired sound and illumination bombs.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land leveling for Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and ‘Azzun.</li> </ul>
NABLUS	<p><b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of al-Lubban al-Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only.</li> <li>(ii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the nearby village of Beit Dajan.</li> <li>(iii) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira al-Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Balata, opened fire during house search, arrested one civilian, and withdrew at 04:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:00, the Israeli army stationed at Huwara checkpoint arrested 2 children under the pretext of finding a grenade with them. The children are: Khaled Khamis Hashash, 13, and Ahmad Bilal Zeitun, 13.</li> <li>(ii) The civilian arrested in the city of Nablus is Hussein Shawkat Abu il-Lel.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr al-Dik.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut and Za'tarah checkpoints and to deny civilian access. At 13:10, the Israeli army closed Za'tarah checkpoint and opened it at 13:40.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Marda, imposed curfew, detained one child and withdrew at 17:45.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir Istiyya and imposed curfew.</li> <li>(iii) At 17:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bab al-zawiyyeh.</li> <li>(iv) At 21:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Brouqin.</li> <li>(v) At 23:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Salfit. The raid recurred at 24:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 15:30, a settler ran over civilian Fares Ghazi Shehadeh on the bridge of the town of al-Zawiyyeh, resulting in his serious injury. He was taken to pension Israeli hospital for treatment.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kafr Hares north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:10, the Israeli army intensified restrictions at the D.C.O. checkpoint that is set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho, and impeded traffic.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on road #90 in the center of the village of al-'Auja and arrested one civilian.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint near the junction of the village of al-'Auja along al-Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>(iii) At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22-dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahour and Bethlehem.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> At 10:45, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint in the area of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and detained a number of military officers from the presidential guards and released them at 12:50 after the intervention of the military liaison.</li> <li>• <b>Raids:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir Salah and searched civilians until 17:30.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Beit Jala.</li> <li>(iii) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Nahalin, where clashes with civilians broke out during patrol.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the area northwest of the town of al-Khader; northwest of the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding the village of al-Walaja.</li> </ul>
<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arroub refugee camp.</p> <p>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <p>(i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance of the town of Beit Ummar, and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <p>(ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the area of al-Nabi Younis.</p> <p>(iii) At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the refugee camp of al-Fawwar, and at 13:00, the Israeli army opened fire indiscriminately towards civilian houses in the camp.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <p>(i) At 15:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron.</p> <p>(ii) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of al-Thahiriyyeh.</p> <p>(iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta, searched one house, and handed one civilian a notice to report to the Israeli intelligence.</p> <p>(iv) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhoul, Dura and al-Sammou'.</p> <p>(v) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit 'Ummar and searched on house.</p> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 16:00, a settler from Susia settlement detained 2 children while they were collecting iron near the settlement. The settler handed the children to the Israeli police and they were released at 23:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction was suspended for the Jewish weekend in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.</li> </ul>
