DISTRICT EVENTS

WEST BANK

Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the occupied city of Jerusalem and Al Agsa Mosque, and prevent civilians from other districts from entering the city, except those possessing Israeli permits. On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order (ii) # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian (iii) access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall (ii) section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram. (iii) On 28 May 2010, the Israeli army closed the eastern entrance to the village of Beit Iksa, which leads to the city of Jerusalem, by an iron gate, and told civilians to pass through Qalandiya checkpoint to occupied Jerusalem city. **Checkpoints: JERUSALEM** The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint (i) a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem. In the morning of 30 November 2010, the Israeli army closed Shu'fat (ii) refugee camp and prevented civilian access, which impeded the access of civilians and students to work and schools. • Raids: (i) At 02:00 on 30 November 2010, the Israeli army raided Ar-Ram town and searched a house. Again at 21:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town until 22:10. At 08:00, the Israeli army raided Al Isawiya village, demolished (ii) a house under construction belonging to Al Qastalawi family and a printing company belonging to the civilian Muhammad Robin Elayyan under the pretext of not being licensed. Consequently,

(iii) At 11:00, the Israeli army raided Kafr Aqab village, stormed a commercial shop and withdrew at 11:45.

confrontations took place with civilians injuring 4 of them.

- (iv) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided the area of Sameeramis, north of occupied Jerusalem city, and patrolled the area.
- (v) At 20:40, the Israeli army raided Beit Anan area where confrontations took place with civilians while patrolling the area.

Destruction of Property: At 11:00, the Israeli army closed in the neighborhood of Ash-Sheikh (i) Jarrah in occupied Jerusalem city a restaurant belonging to the civilian brothers Amjad and Ahmad Idrees Sab Laban and forced them to demolish a room built above the restaurant under the pretext of not being licensed. On 30 November 2010, the Israeli army demolished in the (ii) neighborhood of Ras Khamis in occupied Jerusalem city a residential room under the pretext of not being licensed. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu (i) Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall (ii) gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp. <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village, Safa village and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 11:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint under the overpass (i) leading to the village of Ein Yabrud and searched civilians and vehicles. At 16:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass (ii) RAMALLAH leading to the town of Atara and searched civilians and vehicles. æ Raids: **EL BIREH** (i) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided Kharbatha Bani Hares village, beat a civilian while searching his house and withdrew at 03:00. At 04:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Kobar, searched (ii) a house and withdrew at 05:00. At 06:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Bir Zeit. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of 'Abud, in the periphery of the settlement of Ofarim and north of the villages of Al Lubban Al Gharbi and Rantis. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to 'Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan. **JENIN** Raid: At 03:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Arraba until 04:00.

	<u>Wall Gates</u> : Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	 Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint, allowing civilian access from 06:00 to 22:00. Flying Checkpoint: At 14:15, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the entrance to Bardala village and searched civilians and vehicles until 15:30. Raids: (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Farisiya and its periphery in the Northern Jordan Valley, detained 4 civilians after chasing them while grazing their sheep and released them at a later time and arrested a civilian. (ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tubas, the town of Tammun and the village of Kashda, stormed and searched a pickle factory, detained its workers and released them at a later time. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested in the village of Al Farisiya the civilian Aref Ahmad Tawfiq Daraghmeh.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh. Checkpoint: At 11:10, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road and impeded civilian access. Raids: At 10:20, the Israeli army raided the neighborhood of Irtah in Tulkarm city, set up a flying checkpoint at its entrance, patrolled the area, served summons to 2 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency and withdrew at 11:50. At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarm, searched 3 houses, detained the civilian Ala' Salah Yassin and released him after conducting field questioning with him. Demonstration: At 10:30, a sit in demonstration by families of political prisoners took place in front of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) office in Tulkarm city in solidarity with their children in Israeli jails and demanding their release. Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	 Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. Flying Checkpoints: At 19:55, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Izbat At-Tabib (on Qalqiliya – Nablus main road) and searched civilians and vehicles until 20:30.

- (ii) At 20:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Hajja and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:00.
- (iii) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Jit and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles until 22:00.
- <u>Raid</u>: At 23:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Jayyus, searched a house, detained a Palestinian National Security officer and a Civil Defense officer and released them at 23:55.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and search civilians, including students, with a detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha and prevent the access of its inhabitants. The Israeli army only allows the passage of students to their schools outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through gate # 109.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues on land belonging to the village of Kafr Laqif, north of the settlement of Karni Shomron, on land belonging to the village of Immatin, northeast of the settlement of 'Amano'el, and east of the town of Kafr Thulth near the settlement of Ma'aleh Shomron.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan; the southern entrances to the villages of Duma and Qaryut; and the western entrance to An Naqura village opposite Shavei Shomron settlement.

• Checkpoints:

NABLUS

- (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00.
- (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the road connecting the villages of Burin and Asira Al Qibliya and searched civilians and vehicles until 12:05.
- (ii) At 18:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of Asira Ash Shamaliya and searched civilians and vehicles.

	 (iii) At 19:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on Al Badhan Road (the eastern entrance to Nablus city) and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 21:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Qusin and searched civilians and vehicles. (v) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Awarta village and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: (i) At 20:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Asira Al Qibliya. (ii) At 23:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Madama. (iii) At 01:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and arrested 2 civilian brothers. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the city of Nablus the civilians Mandi Sameer Mustafa Al Ostah and his brother Darweesh. • Settler Violence: At 12:25, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Yitzhar torched agricultural land belonging to civilians in the area that is located south of Madama village destroying a number of olive trees.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances of 2 side roads between the village of Marda and its agricultural land. As of 12:00 on 14 November 2010, the Israeli army allowed the opening of the northern entrance to the city of Salfit (that has been closed for 7 years) and allowed the access of passenger buses only. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access. Flving Checkpoints: At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Kifl Hares and searched civilians and vehicles until 16:00. At 19:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Yasuf and searched civilians and vehicles. Arrest: At 18:30, the Israeli army arrested at Za'tara junction checkpoint the civilian Nur Ad-Deen Hafez Mahmoud Sawaftah from Tubas city. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area north of the town of Deir Istiya (southeast of the settlement of 'Amanu'el).
JERICHO	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks. Checkpoints: (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00.

	 (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those with permits. • Flying Checkpoints: At 13:35, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and searched civilians and vehicles until 14:50. At 16:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction leading to Road # 90 in the middle of Al-Auja village and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raid: At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Jericho and Ein As Sultan refugee camp in the city, searched a number of houses, arrested a civilian in the refugee camp and withdrew at 03:00. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested in Ein As-Sultan refugee camp the civilian Muhammad Khamis Ibrahim Jahalin.
	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. As of 15 September 2007, the Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access, pursuant to military order # 07/02, to 22 dunum area confiscated according to military order # 07/31 to establish a crossing point in the area of Al Mazmuriya between the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town
BETHLEHEM	 Flying Checkpoints: At 08:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Fajjar. Again at 17:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles. At 09:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on An-Nashash junction (the southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and searched civilians and vehicles until 09:55. At 22:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Tuqu' and searched civilians and vehicles. At 00:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction leading to Dar Salah village (the eastern entrance to Beit Sahur city) and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 11:45, the Israeli army raided Tuqu' town, searched a house, served summon to the civilian Muhammad Ali Al Hammam to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency and withdrew at 12:50.
	(ii) At 18:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Walaja and

arrested a civilian.

- (iii) At 00:20, the Israeli army raided the villages of Dar Salah and Ash Shawawra and patrolled the area.
- <u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested in the village of Al Walaja the civilian Saqr Muhammad Mustafa Al-A'raj.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and the city of Beit Jala; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Ephrata; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # 09/06 closing the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta, evacuating those inside it and preventing civilians from accessing it. This is the land seized for military purposes for the construction of the Wall.

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the towns of Yatta and As-Samoa'.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass leading to Halhul town. Again at 16:45 and at 21:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 08:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Fawwar junction and searched civilians and vehicles.

- (iii) At 17:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the city of Hebron (off bypass road # 35) and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 20:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the area of Farsh Al Hawa north of Hebron city (off bypass road # 35) and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Kahil and searched civilians and vehicles.


• Raids:

- (i) At 05:00 on 30 November 2010, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, searched a house and arrested a civilian. Again at 13:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area.
- (ii) At 22:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ummar, closed all its entrances with military checkpoints and combed the area around the military observation tower set up at its entrance.
- (iii) At 22:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Bani Na'im, positioned troops near the civil police station in the town, patrolled the area and withdrew at 23:45.
- (iv) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura and arrested a PLC member.
- (v) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Adh Dhahiriya.
- (vi) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the towns of Sa'ir and Ash Shuyukh, searched a house and arrested a civilian from Ash Shuyukh town.

• Arrests:

- (i) The Israeli army arrested in Hebron city the civilian Bilal Hamed At-Taweel.
- (ii) The Israeli army arrested in Dura town the civilian Nayef Ar Rujoub (a PLC member)
- (iii) The Israeli army arrested in Ash Shuyukh town the civilian Na'el Shareef Issa Halayqah.
- **Physical Assault:** On 30 November 2010, the Israeli army severely beat in Jaber neighborhood in the old city of Hebron 10-year-old child Mahmoud Raed Said As-Salaymeh causing him contusions.
- School Obstruction: At 14:30, the Israeli army laid siege on Sader School that is located near the settlement of Kiryat Arba' in the old city of Hebron and prevented students from leaving the school under the pretext of protecting a group of Israeli settlers touring the area. The Israeli army withdrew at 15:00.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

GAZA STRIP



• Closure of Crossing Points:

- (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.
- (ii) Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is open for the departure and entry of civilians and patients.
- (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.

RAFAH

- (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entry of food, humanitarian assistance, a quantity of diesel for the electricity plant, cooking gas, 18 truckloads of iron parts and cement for the interest of UNRWA funded projects and the export of 2 truckloads of strawberry.
- <u>Air Patrol</u>: In the evening of 30 November 2010, Israeli F-16 warplanes patrolled the skies and conducted mock air raids above Rafah district.

GENERAL

POLITICAL PRISONERS

• The Israeli military court in Bi'r As-Sabe' sentenced political prisoner Said Muhsen from Gaza Strip to 10 years in prison.
