WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

Attack:

- (i) At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents protesting against "Brivar plan" and as a result injured 2 journalists: Amin Siyam and Sa'ed Al-Qurd and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Moath Muslih near Bab Al-Amoud area.
- Home Demolition: On November 30th 2013, Israeli forces enforced Nidal Amira to demolish his 440 m² in Sur Bahar village and fined him a hefty financial penalty for alleged being built without a licence.

• Wall Gates:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Mattack: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas gernades towards several residents for alleged stoning Settler Violence: At 18:015, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Mughier village then withdrew at 21:30 as residents attempted to prevent the settler attack Demonstration: At 14:25, a demonstration took place near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp protesting against the Israeli "Bravar" plan during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several demonstrator, assaulted and injured several residents then temporarily detained 2 residents after assaulting them: Abdel Jawad Hamayil {Hospitalised with contusions} and Zayed Al-Shu'abi then released them at a later. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.
JENIN	 Raid: At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village. At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Bir Al-Basha village, set up a checkpoint, stormed a vehicle sales lot and several homes then summoned 4 residents: Nasri Ghawardeh, Bassim Ghawarda, Ehab Abu Jumhour and Iz Aldin Ghawarda to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:20. At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuhada' village, stormed several homes, summoned 6 residents: Musa Asous, Rabi' Turkman, Majd Al-Diri, Ahmad Al-Diri, Hamam Assous and Nidal Wahshi then withdrew at 01:00. At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher and summoned Mohammad Al-Hantouli to report to Israeli intelligent for questioning then withdrew at 02:00.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

TUBAS	 Raid: (i) At 02:00 on November 30th 2013, Israeli forces raided Aqaba and summoned Mahmoud Ghanam to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'a village. (iii) At 06:50, Israeli forces raided Tubas and took photographs of a mosque.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Detention: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Wall Gate (101) located in West Tulkarem detained Maram Hasouneh, a resident of Nablus for allegedly carrying a knife. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flying Checkpoint: At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and temporarily detained Badran Khalid then released him at a later time. Raid: At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village and fired stun grenades. Temporary Detention: At 13:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 residents: Islam Dwikat and Nassim Shawashneh on agricultural land near "Karni Shomron" settlement then released them at a later time. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. - Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting (vii) Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Wadi Fuqin village.
- Raid: At 21:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Asagra village until 22:25.
- Attack: At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to

"Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna. (iii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Yatta and Al-Samou' Raid: At dawn on December 1st 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed a home and detained a resident. **Detention:** (i) At 15:15, Israeli forces detained Saleh Husni at the entrance of Al-Urub camp. (ii) Israeli forces detained Badran Abu Ayash in Beit Ummar. **Temporary Detention:** At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Mohammad Ramadan, a resident Nablus then released him at 13:55. Attack: At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Kamal Sarahneh leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. Assault on Property: On November 30th 2013, Israeli forces prevented several farmers from reaching their agricultural land in Um Al-Aris area located in south Yatta. Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town for Sabbath holiday.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
