<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces set up several checkpoints in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, temporarily detained several residents then released them later. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and stormed several merchant shops. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents, temporarily detained the child: Haytham Obied (13 years old) and released him later. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of November 30th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at an entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound detained two residents: Musbah Abu Sbieh and Hamza Al-Zaghir. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Abdel-Khalil Al-Abbassi in Silwan neighbourhood. (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Salah Al-Din road in Jerusalem detained Mohammad Hijaz. (iv) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Atrash after storming his home in the old city of Jerusalem and confiscated his computer. (v) At 15:00, Israeli forces detained Sufiyan Abu Jamal in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood. (vi) Israeli forces detained two residents: Nayef Abu Rami and Nur Far’oun in Al-Eizariya. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at Hata gate, which

	<p>leads to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained Inhar Al-Ajlouni (16 years old) then released her at 10:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00 on November 29th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Thuri neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result, left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On the morning of December 1st 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Eisawiya and demolished a home owned by Ishaq Hamad for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of November 30th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 22:30 on November 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu village with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village and summoned Assef Ghanimat to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 09:35, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and Al-Bireh city 'until 11:45. (iii) At 16:25 and again at 05:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Illu, clashed with several residents, stormed several homes, occupied 2 homes owned by Ali Badr and Radwan Zabaydeh and converted their rooftops into Military posts. (iv) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Beitin village until 22:25. (v) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. (vi) At 06:40, Israeli forces raided Dier Ammar Camp, stormed several homes and occupied Hassan Musa's home and converted its rooftop into a military post. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Bassam Hamad in Silwad.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Quffin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:30. (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya until 20:20. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Zieta, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 23:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:10, Israeli forces temporarily detained Mohammad Jabr (A resident of Kafr Jamal) as he was positioned behind the wall gate then released him at 23:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 19:00. (ii) At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 21:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:40. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village, stormed a home then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

<p>NABLUS</p>	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 19:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus, detained a resident then withdrew at 00:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Tamer Sharif in Nablus.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily detained two residents: Zahi Abu Tabiekh and Maher Assad (Both residents of Tulkarem) then released them at 21:35.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces closed Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District then reopened it later. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 12:25. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 13:55. (iii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Mu'arajat road (which connects Ramallah and Jericho) until 15:50. (iv) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the center of Al-Oja village until 18:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Marj Al-Na'ja village until 24:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Layth Malouh as he was travelling to Jordan then released him at 13:40.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Aqbat Hassnah area located along the main road leading to West Bethlehem until 17:50. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:30. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Husan village, summoned Saleem Shuma to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning until 22:45.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.

	<p>(vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Safaa village, clashed with several residents, served a halt to construction order for a home owned by Munir Akhalil and a livestock den owned by Zaghal Abu Mariya for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Kahil and detained a University student after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:40 on November 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Ibrahim Sarahna (17 years old) and Ayman Khashan during their raid into Al-Fuwar camp as mentioned in the previous report. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, tourists and students entering from the Republic of Egypt. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance.
