## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) On 30 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Issawiyye village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
  - (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks.
  - (iv) At 15:15 on 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed road near Panorama Hotel in Ras Al-Amud in Jerusalem with cement blocks.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
  - (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
  - (i) At 13:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bir Nibala junction and searched civilians and vehicles.
- **Raids:**
  - (i) At 02:30 Israeli forces raided Bir Nibala town and searched civilian homes.
  - (ii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Isawiyye village, stormed into and searched several civilian homes and arrested 4 civilians including 1 child.
- **Arrests:**
  - (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces arrested at Shufat checkpoint in Jerusalem child Mohammad Al-Bayya, 14, from Shufat refugee camp.
  - (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces arrested in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem child Majdi Wael Abu Tayeh, 17, after beating him.
  - (iii) The four civilians arrested in Isawiyye village are Yazan Ali Obeid, 14, Nouredin Sultan Obeid, Mohammad Ghaseb Obeid and his brother Salameh.
- **Attacks:**
  - (i) At 16:25, Israeli forces near the Separation Wall alongside Qatanna village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces at Ein Loza in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces on Mt. of Olives fired live ammunition and stun

Of Olives football Club players and injured some.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>House Demolition:</u></b> On 30 November Israeli forces forced the family of Nabil Ishaq Al-Disi living near Jaffa gate in the old city of Jerusalem to demolish an addition under the pretext of unlicensed construction. Another option the family had was to pay ILS 30,000. The addition is 3 square meters.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 10:00, Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces raided Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 11:00, Jewish settlers from east of Mikhmas village razed agricultural land and stole caravans belonging to Palestinian civilians.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul>
