- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Since October 18th 2013 at 14:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) Since November 10th 2013 at 14:40, Israeli forces closed the bypass road leading to Khirbeit Al-Dier village with concrete blocks

- <u>Attack:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents as they were exiting a mosque after evening prayers for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and firing Tank Artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah. Palestinian gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Israeli forces positioned behind the border fence near North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Palestinian Attack: At 12:30, Palestinian gunmen opened fire towards Israeli military vehicles near the border fence and as a result Israeli forces returned fire towards Beit Hanun,
