JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) Since September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic as they searched vehicles using Police dogs. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jabal Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem until 08:30. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Sultan road in Jerusalem until 08:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces detained 5 residents including 4 children: Suhayeb Afana (16 years old), Mohammad Atwan (15 years old), Mujahid Atwan (16 years old), Lu'ay Hamada (14 years old) and Mohammad Atwan after storming their homes in Sur Bahar village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured an unidentified individual. • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> At 09:15, Israeli settler under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 10:00, Israeli military began paving a road to connect Jabal Mukabbir with Sheikh Sa'ed village in Jerusalem after confiscating 300 dunums (acres) of residential owned land. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Osama Assi in Bet Liqya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Ofar" military prison fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Omar Abu Al-Rub (16 years old) after a tear gas grenade canister struck his face leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Asireh Al-Shamaliya until 16:20. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa'

- towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.

 - **Attack:** At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Anas Awawdeh (17 years old) in Khursa village.
 - **Obstruction of Medical Sector:** At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint in Tel Al-Rumaydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron prevented an Ambulance transferring the patient Hanna Abu Haykal to a hospital then allowed the ambulance to pass through after the intervention of International monitors from TIPH (**Temporary International Presence in Hebron**).

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval Vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Rafah.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
