JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
 - (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
 - (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddo town and searched civilians and vehicles until 00:15.
- **Raids:**
 - (i) At 08:30 Israeli forces raided Shufat refugee camp and detonated the home of martyr’s family Ibrahim Al-Akari and caused severe material damage to neighbouring homes. Clashes broke out between civilians and Israeli forces resulting in the injury of 3 civilians (including 1 child): Mahmoud Bar Rabee’, 15, Ala Imad Alqam and Adel Mousa Omar Mousa.
 - (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Anata town, clashed with civilians and seriously injured in the eye a child called Khalil Mohammad Ismail, 15.
 - (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Izariyye town and stormed into 1 civilian home.
 - (iv) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Isawiyye town and arrested 1 civilian.
 - (v) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Hizma village.
 - (vi) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis town and clashed with civilians during patrol.
- **Arrests:**
 - (i) At 03:45, Israeli forces arrested in RaS Al-Amud neighbourhood civilian Ziyad Ayoub Abu Wahdan.
 - (ii) At 04:25, Israeli forces arrested in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem civilian Mohammad Al-Hashlamoun.
 - (iii) The civilian arrested in Isawiyye village is Mohammad Halayqa.
- **Attacks:**
 - (i) At 21:45, Israeli forces in Silwan neighbourhood fired tear gas canisters at

	<p>civilians for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(ii) At 21:55, Israeli forces near Isawiyye entrance fired tear gas canisters towards civilians in the Old City of Jerusalem for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assaults on Property:</u> At 03:10, Israeli forces demolished prayer room under construction near Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Attacks on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:30, Jewish settlers backed up by Israeli forces raided Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Sath Marhaba area east of Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured civilian Anas Shawamreh.

(ii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya city and patrolled it until 06:10. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces guarding the Separation Wall alongside Qalqilya city fire rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas canister and stun grenades at civilians, injuring 5 civilians and dozens suffocated as a result of gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since 17 December 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Aqraba town with Yanun village with dirt mounds. (iv) On 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Bourin, Awarta and Osrin villages and the agricultural road connecting Aqraba and Qabalan with dirt mounds. (ii) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Beta town and searched civilians and vehicles until 11:00.

	<p>(iii) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of the village Odala and searched civilians and vehicles until 11:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided the town of Aqraba, stormed into 3 civilians homes, detained 2 civilians and released them at a later time after investigation: Mousa Ahmad Diriyye and Youssef Munir Awad Bani Fadil, and then withdrew at 02:35. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus city and clashed with civilians while detonating a 4-story building owned by prisoner Ragheb Eleiwi charged of killing 2 settlers near Beit Fourik town. The explosion caused damage to neighbouring buildings. Clashes between civilians and Israeli forces broke out resulting in the injury of Mohammad Sanad Manko. In addition, Israeli forces arrested 1 military from NSF after searching his home and then withdrew at 06:00 (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Ourif village and stormed into 2 civilian homes. (iv) At 04:45, Israeli forces raided Beta town, stormed 2 civilian homes, arrested 1 civilian and physically assaulted civilian Murhej Ahmad Abdallah Jamil (v) At dawn on 3 December 2015, Israeli forces raided Aqraba town and arrested 2 civilians. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The military arrested in Nablus is Mutaz Mahnmoud Mohammad Fashafsheh. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
