WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city for the alleged stabbing of an Israeli settler.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata.
- Raid: At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed and searched a furniture shop.
- Injury: At 17:20, the child: Saleem Abu Sneineh (16 years old) {resident of Al-Eizariya} was injured after Israeli forces opened fire towards him as he allegedly stabbed 3 Israeli settlers at "Rami Livni" store located in Mishour Adumin settlement in Khan Al-Hamra area and as a result injured the 3 settlers during which Israeli forces detained 3 children and stormed Al-Eizariya during which they clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home and temporarily detained 3 residents: Samer Abu Sneienh, Tariq Abu Sneienh and Murad Abu Sneienh and released them after interrogation by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 21:10.

• Detention:

(i) On December 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Imad Ali and Nidal Al-Fasfous in Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM

(ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ass'ad Al-Labban (16 years old), Mustafa Al-Samhoudi (16 years old) and Nabil Masalmeh (16 years old) {All residents of Al-Eizariya} in at "Rami Livni" store located in Mishour Adumin settlement in Khan Al-Hamra area.

• Attack:

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents: Imad Ali (12 years old) {hit with a rubber coated steel bullet in the eye}.
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis and near the entrance of Al-Eisawiya and Shu'fat camp and near the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the Paramedic: Anas Hadad {A resident of Al-Eisawiya}.
- **<u>Destruction of Property:</u>** At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Shu'fat camp and demolished an old building and 20 merchant shops owned by Al-Dijani family in order to expand the area of Shu'fat checkpoint.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) At 22:30 on November 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Halamish" settlement junction.
- (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Ziet.

	tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 children: Mohammad Nakhlah (16 years old), Karim Nakhlah (8 years old), Mohammad Abu Nassar (17 years old) and Zied Subhi and the child Mohammad Al-Ramahi (16 years old) was injured after being rammed by an Israeli Military Jeep. - (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the North and West entrances of Taqou' until 12:45.
- (ii) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Tagou' until 20:00.
- (iii) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Tagou' until 23:25.

• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on December 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed six homes, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers and detained a child.
- (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, served halt to construction orders for two homes owned by: Mohammad Sabah and Ashraf Isa for allegedly being built without a licence.
- (iii)At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:35.
- (iv)At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed several home, detained three residents then withdrew at 06:50.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Sbatin (16 years old) in Husan village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Hassan Thawabteh in Beit Fajjar.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Akram Al-Amour, Mohammad Al-Amour and Mohammad Jaseb Al-Amour in Taqou'.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area located in south Hebron until 09:20.
- (ii) At 17:00 and again at 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until 21:00.
- (iii)At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction until 20:30.
- (iv)At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Huwar area located in North Halhul until 21:20.

• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on December 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou' and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Haska area in Halhul.
- (iii)At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and a print press then withdrew at 12:30.
- (iv)At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya, stormed and searched a merchant shop after breaking down the main entrance and detained two residents.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mo'ayad Abu Tabeekh in Al-Samou'.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Tamr Kabja and Ruhi Kabja in Tarqumiya.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Zahad area in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained several school children as they were going home then released them at 13:50.

• Attack:

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Duwarah area in Sa'ir fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child: Mu'taz Jarradat (14 years old) then released him at 18:00.
- (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Takrouri area in Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Destruction of Property:** At 10:45, Israeli forces stormed Al-Musafer area located in east Yatta and demolished a livestock shed owned by Nassar Abu Abed for allegedly being built without a licence.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and injured a fisherman.

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

	Attack: (i) At 06:30 on December 3 rd 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Jabaliya. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya and as a result injured the fisherman: Nizar Abu Rayala.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance. Detention: On the evening of December 3rd 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing detained two unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel.
