	placed nails along the main road, impeding the flow of traffic; they withdrew

	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.

	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at
	the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

	(ii) Israeli forces detained Maher Harb, Hussien Shalbiya, Rida Khaled and
	Hussam Al-Ruzza during their raids into Balata refugee camp and Ein B Al-
	Maa refugee camp.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two
	detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to
	Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years,
	and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of
	traffic.

### **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on (ii) the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 09:00 Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Al-Dweik at the (i) northern entrance of Jericho At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of (ii) Jericho city. (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jiftlik At 23:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fasayil (iv) village. **Raids:** At 09:45, Israeli forces raided Jericho, providing protection for a group of Israeli settlers during their raid on an area allegedly housing a Synagogue, set up a flying checkpoint and inspected cars then withdrew at 12:35. **Closure:** The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the (i) exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Bag'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. **Checkpoint:** The Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Raids: At 02:00 on December 4<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces raided Husan village and (i) detained 2 residents. At 14:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Jala and damaged an entrance gate for land (ii) **BETHLEHEM** owned by Nassar Nassar then withdrew at 14:50. At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Ibeidiya town. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar village. (iv) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader town, searched a home and detained (v) 2 residents. **Detentions:** Israeli forces detained Fadi Shusha and Alaa Shusha during their raid into (i) Husan village. Israeli forces detained Ali Saleh and Ashraf Salah Al-Din during their raid (ii) into Al-Khader. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq (i) Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition

to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues
to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables
market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village
- (v) Since 15. 10. 2011, Israeli forces closed two entrances leading to Beit Ummar town.

### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Fuwwar junction.
- (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Younis area on the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem.
- (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint in Hebron's Old City and detained 2 residents, including a child.
- (iv) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Majd village.
- (v) At 07:50, Israeli forces set up 3 flying checkpoints in Wadi Qabboun area north of Hebron.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou, searched a home and briefly detained Salman Yousef.
- (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron city
- (iii) At dawn on December 5<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, searched a home, detained a resident and confiscated a personal computer
- Attack: At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Ummar fired teargas and stun grenades towards residents for allegedly throwing stones.

#### Detention:

- (i) Israeli force detained Faraj Al-Karaki (16 years) and Khaldoun Shahin during the raid on Hebron's Old City.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Murad Al-Khalil during their raid into Beit Ummar.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
