WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint and impeded the free flow of Traffic.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 03:00 on December 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan, stormed a home and summoned Jaber Jumhour to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
 - (ii) At 04:00 on December 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Jadirah village and detained a resident.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 17:45, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained the child: Yathrib Abdel-Rahman (16 years old){ A resident of Beit Duqqu} after Israeli forces sprayed pepper spray onto his face which left him suffocated with burnt eyes for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Azzam in Al-Jadira village.
- **Expulsion:** On December 4th 2014, Israeli military authorities submitted orders for the expulsion of three residents: Daoud Al-Ghoul (A resident of Silwan), Majdi Darwish (A resident of Al-Eisawiya) and Salah Dirbas (A resident of Al-Eisawiya) for a period of 5 months from November 30th 2014 until April 30th 2015).
- **Attack:** On December 4th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya and in Bab Hata gate area in the old city of Jerusalem, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Assault on Property:** At 13:00, Israeli forces stormed and searched the home of Akram Al-Saharafeh in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem, confiscated his

	<p>computer and summoned him to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 11:30 on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces blocked the main road near Al-Jalazoun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit. (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Eiyoun Al-Haramiya junction until 19:20. (iii) At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Abboud and Deir Abu Mash’al village until 19:30. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah bridge in North Bir Ziet temporarily detained Anas Al-Sabah (A resident of Orif village in Nablus) then released him at 20:05. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Illu fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Mohammad Nasssar (17 years old) and Basel Ismail (17 years old).

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba junction. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qabatiya junction until 02:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on December 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Zabada village and detained a resident. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yusef Amarnah in Zabadiya village.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Anabta until 01:35. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Nur Al-Shams camp, stormed and searched two homes, detained two residents and confiscated a computer then withdrew at 03:55. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nafez Abu Obied and Mohammad Al-Qa’uri in Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun Bridge. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged stoning. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrances of Kafr Thaulth and Izbit Al-Tabib village • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib, clashed with several residents and temporarily detained three residents: Fadi Sha’our, Na’im Sh’aour and Mohammad Tabahiya then withdrew at 22:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atman Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. At 14:00, Israeli forces closed the Iron Gate entrance then reopened it at 14:25 The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq, impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 22:40. (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yatma village junction until 23:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Qusra village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 15:45. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Jurish and Qusra villages, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:00. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Burin village until 23:55. (iv) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Nablus, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:55. (v) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Qabalan and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:40 on December 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Amir Jabr (A resident of Aqraba) during their raid into Osirin village as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Amir Ya’ish in Nablus.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Majed Mir’I Qarwat Bani Hassan.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, again at 15:55 and again at 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:25. (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho until 21:35. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u>

	<p>(i) At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Mohammad Subieh as he was returning from Jordan then released him at 20:50.</p> <p>(ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ahmad Abu Al-Rub then released him at 21:20.</p>
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Kafr Etsioyn" settlement, temporarily detained four residents including three National Security force officers: Maher Al-Qawasmeh, Fadi Jawabrah, Tamer Jawabreh and Mohammad Mazin then released them at 16:00. • Raid: At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed several homes, summoned 2 residents: Ramzi Dariya and Ibrahim Dariya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. • Detention: At 02:00 on December 4th 2014, Israeli forces detained Abed Al-Amour during their raid into Taqou' as mentioned in the previous report. • Temporary Detention: At 02:00 on December 4th 2014, Israeli forces temporarily detained three children: Ahmad Abu Mifrih (12 years old), Bara Al-Amour (13 years old) and Mohammad Abu Mifrih (12 years old) then released them at 11:00. • Attack: At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned in AL-Obidiya camp in Bethlehem

HEBRON	fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on December 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ulla and detained a resident. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (iii) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed several merchant shops, detained three residents then withdrew at 13:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Maher Abu Alma in Beit Ulla. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ahmad Abu Jahisha, Khaled Bashir and Bakri Farjallah in Ithna. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained two children: Ayman Khalifa (14 years old) and Anas Jamal (15 years old) in Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron then released them at 19:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Um Al-Khier village located in east Yatta assaulted Zied Al-Hathalin and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 20:50, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in the old city of Hebron stoned residents and vehicles and as a result, injured Ahamd Al-Nathseh leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
