JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks. (iv) At 15:15 on 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Panorama Hotel in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement locks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata town and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 03:00 Israeli forces raided Abu Dis town stormed into the home of civilian Ismail Ibrahim Halabiyye and detonated the walls of his home and withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on 4 December 2015, Israeli forces arrested 2 civilians from Qalandia refugee camp: Said Shehadeh and Ali Mohammad Al-Iraqi. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces arrested civilian Islam Al-Sinawi from Izariyye town. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces in Ras Kabseh area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces in Izariyye town fired tear gas canisters towards civilians in the Old City of Jerusalem for alleged stoning, and targeted an ambulance with tear gas canisters resulting in the suffocation of 5 paramedics. (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters at civilians for alleged stoning. (iv) At 13:30, Israeli forces in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 22:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Jit village and arrested 2 civilians. • <u>Raids:</u> At 17:05, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Jayyous town and clashed with civilians until 18:00. • <u>Arrests:</u> The 2 civilians arrested at the junction of Jit are: Mohammad Tayseer Othman Al-Fayoumi and Mohammad Shahin. Both from Qalqilya city. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces guarding the Separation Wall alongside Qalqilya city fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades at civilians, injuring 2 civilians (including 1 child): Awad Khamis Ghalban, 16, and Samer mahmoud Ali Ilayyan and dozens suffocated as a result of gas inhalation. In addition Israeli forces detained child Hassan Mustafa Allan, 17, and released him at 01:10. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 12:15, local civilians in Kafr Qaddoum village set out in a demonstration in protest of continuous closure of the northern entrance of the village. Israeli forces fires rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas canisters and stun grenades at protestors resulting in the injury of some demonstrators and the suffocation of others. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (ii) Since 30 July 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified restrictions At Zaatara checkpoint and impeded free flow of traffic. • Arrests: At 18:00, Israeli forces arrested at Zaatara junction checkpoint civilian Mahmoud Mohammad Mahmoud Khaled from bet Al-Ma refugee camp for alleged possession of a knife.

BETHLEHEM

 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
 - (iii) Israeli forces continue to close the road connecting Cremisan area north of Beit Jala and Walaja village with barbed wires and steel gate, and the road connecting Surif town with Jabaa village with cement blocks.
 - (iv) Since 10:45 on 8 September 2015, the Israeli army agricultural road in Arab Rashaydeh near Ma'ale Amos settlement with dirt mounds.
 - (v) At 15:30 on 20 November 2015, Israeli forces closed eastern entrance of Junana village with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) At 13:10 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) At 18:00 on 27 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction of Barbara in Ras Beit Jala with cement blocks.

 - (iii) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jala and searched civilians and vehicles until 14:45.
- **Raids:** At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed into 1 civilian home and withdrew at 02:15.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On 15 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilet Al-Mayye and Al-Deirat villages east of Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 14:10 on 23 November 2015, Israeli forces closed of Al-Kom village north of Beit Awwa with cement blocks. (vii) At 08:00 on 01 December 2015, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint at the entrance of Shuhada' Street and denied civilian access and changed direction of traffic. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, Israeli forces raided Ras Al-Jora area in Hebron city clashed with civilians and injured 3 civilians: Ali Jihad Abeido, Faris Mahmoud al-Haymooni and Ahmad Daoud Atiyye Irfaiyye. (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces raided Halhul town, clashed with civilians and seriously injured child Saber Issa Abdel Halim Zammareh, 15. (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron city and patrolled it until 01:35. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces arrested at the entrance of Beit Awwa town child Ahmad Mohammad Hassan Al-Sharawneh, 13 from Deir Samet village for allegedly possessing a knife. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar town fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades at civilians for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces near Al-Kasara area south of the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear gas canisters and stun grenades at civilians for alleged stoning, injuring civilian Ahmad Ibrahim Al-Najjar.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by firing two artillery shells from behind the Green Line towards Northern Gaza, Gaza and central Gaza and Khan Younis, injuring 39 civilians. • Palestinian militants broke ceasefire by opening fire at an Israeli patrol alongside Gaza Strip borders (according to Israeli claims).
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attacks: At 14:00, Israeli forces fired tear gas canisters and bullets from their position behind the Green Line towards civilians in the vicinity of Beit Hanun-Erez Crossing during a protest against Israeli desecration of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, resulting in the injury of 4 civilians and suffocation of 3 other civilians as a result of tear gas.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attacks: At 13:30, Israeli forces fired tear gas canisters and bullets from their position behind the Green Line towards civilians near Shija'iyah-Nahal Oz Crossing east of Gaza during a protest against Israeli desecration of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, resulting in the injury of 14 civilians and suffocation of two other civilians as a result of tear gas.

(iv) At 13:30, Israeli forces fired tear gas canisters and bullets from their position behind the Green Line towards civilians east on Al-Farahin areas located east of Abassan Al-Kabira town during a protest against Israeli desecration of the Al-Aqsa Mosque, resulting in the injury of 10 civilians and suffocation of 5 other civilians as a result of tear gas. • Palestinian Attacks: In the afternoon of 4 December 2015, Palestinian militants opened fire at an Israeli military patrol alongside the borders east of Khan Younis (according to Israeli claims).
