	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at Beit Anun and Al-Fuwar camp junctions.

- (i) At dawn on December 5th 2012 and again at dawn on December 6th 20912, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained 2 residents and 3 other2 including 2 children after assaulting Mansour Sabarna (15 years old) leaving him with head injuries as well as detaining 2 more residents making the total detentions to 5.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Surif, stormed a home and summoned Baha Arara to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

Detention:

- (i) At 00:15 on December 15th 2012, Israeli forces detained Qassim Hadar and Nassir Hadar in Yatta.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mansour Sabarna (15 years old), Fawzi Abu Ayash (17 years old), Ahmad Abu Mariya, Omar Awad and Billal Akhlil.
- <u>Home Demolition</u>: On December 5th 2012, Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish a 3 floor home owned by Ribhi Jawarba in Al-Urub camp for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On December 5th 2012, Israeli forces served a demolition order to demolish a granite cutting factory owned by Ibrahim Al-Alami for allegedly being built without a licence on the main road connecting Hebron and Jerusalem.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
