JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On December 5th 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 35 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces closed Wadi Al-Hilweh road in Silwan neighbourhood and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces detained Amir Al-Dabash in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya and in Al-Tur neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 11:30, on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Bet El Settlement located near Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 23:55. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and summoned Ghassan Al-Rimawi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:45. • <u>Detention:</u> At 15:45, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Rabi (A resident of Deir Ghassaneh) as he was working on a construction site in Abboud village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned at a Military watch tower located at the entrance of Silwad temporarily detained two residents including a child: Mohammad Hammad (14 years old) and Nidal Hamad then released them at 13:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Sinjil fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including a child: those identified: Fakher Shabanah (17 years old) and Islam Tawafshah (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Mohammad Al-Barghouthi and Majd Abdel Al-Majid. (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Ofar” prison/ Military base fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:20, Israeli; forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Mohammad Ghanawmeh (17 years old). (v) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Qassim Abed Rabbou. (vi) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 06:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ra’i.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyus and Sir Village until 20:10. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and as a result injured Bahar Nazal (A photo Journalist) well as leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army closed with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha at 15:50 and to deny civilian access then reopened it at 17:30. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Orif and Einbus village junctions until 16:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village until 11:00. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed a home (under

	<p>construction) then withdrew at 17:10.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Khirbiet Taweel area in Aqrabah and uprooted 50 Olive trees owned by Shaher Jama'. (ii) At 15:45, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Al-Saba' area located in east Burin, attempted to damage the main electricity generator which provides electricity to the area, stoned 2 homes and as a result damaged a home owned by Billal Eid and Dakhil Abu Rasli during which Israeli forces fire stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who attempted to prevent the settler assault.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 21:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:30.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village stormed a home and summoned Yusef Al-Shiekh and Ibrahim Al-Shiekh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:30. (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, searched a home then withdrew at 00:30. (iv) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Beit Jallah until 04:45. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and assaulted Samer Mohammad (A resident of AlAyda camp) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'assra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented resident's from reaching the demonstration site.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured two residents.
